



Crochet Flower Cushion

Step-by-Step Tutorial

FINISHED SIZE
Approx. 16 in (40 cm) square

- MATERIALS**
- Worsted weight (4) cotton or acrylic yarn
 - Colors:
 - Cream (A)
 - Dusty Pink (B)
 - White (C)
 - Yellow (D)
 - Green (E)
 - 5.0 mm (H) crochet hook
 - Yarn needle
 - Scissors
 - 16 in (40 cm) pillow form

COLOR GUIDE



1. OVERVIEW

The cushion is made in panels and seamed together, then the flowers and leaves are appliquéd on the front.

Panels: Front (Flower Panel) + Back (Solid Panel)

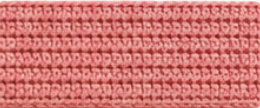
Techniques: Single Crochet, Double Crochet, Bobble Stitch, Slip Stitch, Fasten Off, Seaming, Appliqué

2. HOW TO MAKE

A. FRONT PANEL

Use Color B (Dusty Pink)

- Ch 51.
- Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and across. (50 sts)
- Row 2–34:** Ch 1, turn, sc across. Fasten off.



B. TOP & BOTTOM BOBBLE BORDERS

Use Color A (Cream)

- Ch 51.
- Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and across.
- Row 2 (Bobble Row):**

Bobble: Yo, insert hook in next st, draw up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops. Repeat 4 more times in the same st (5 loops on hook). Yo, pull through all 5 loops. Ch 1 to secure.

Work 1 bobble in each st across. Fasten off.

Make 2 strips (for top and bottom).



C. FLOWER (Make 3)

Use Colors C (White) and D (Yellow)

Center (Yellow):

- Magic ring, ch 1.
- 6 sc in ring. Pull tight. Join with sl st. Fasten off.



Petals (White):

- Join white yarn in any st.
- Ch 2 (counts as hdc), 2 hdc, ch 2, sl st in same st. (1 petal made)
- Sl st to next st and repeat around (6 petals total).
- Fasten off.



D. LEAVES (Make 6)

Use Color E (Green)

- Ch 10.
- Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc, sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc, sl st. Fasten off.
- Repeat to make 6 leaves.



E. STEMS

Use Color E (Green)

- Ch 18.
- Sl st in 2nd ch from hook and across.
- Make 3 stems.



F. ASSEMBLY

- Sew 3 flowers onto the pink panel, evenly spaced.
- Sew a stem under each flower.
- Arrange and sew 2 leaves on each side of the stems.

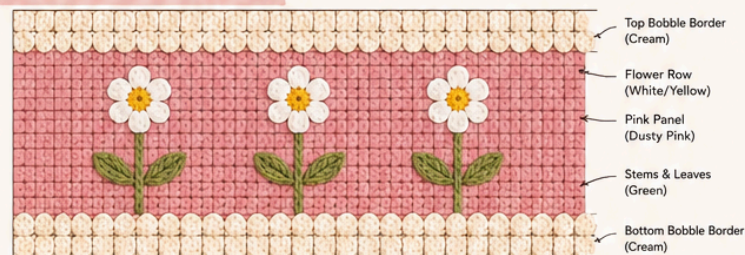


G. FINISHING

- Sew the top bobble border to the top edge of the pink panel.
- Sew the bottom bobble border to the bottom edge.
- Make the back panel the same size as the front panel using Color A (Cream) with Rows 1–36 of single crochet.
- Place panels right sides together and seam 3 sides.
- Insert pillow form and seam the last side closed.

5. ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- yo = yarn over
- rep = repeat
- () = work instructions in brackets
- *...* = repeat the instruction between the asterisks

CROCHET PILLOW COVER DAISY BLOOM

A sweet and charming pillow cover featuring delicate daisy flowers, textured stitches, and a beautiful scalloped edge.



MATERIALS

- Worsted weight cotton yarn:
 - Cream (Main)
 - Dusty Pink
 - Green
 - Yellow
- 4.0 mm (G/6) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- 16" (40 cm) pillow form
- Scissors

GAUGE

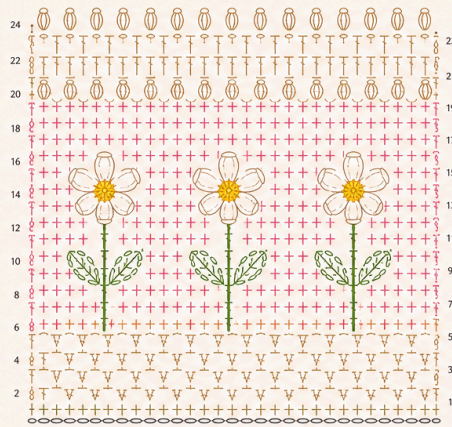
4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm) =
20 dc x 10 rows

FINISHED SIZE
Approx. 16" (40 cm)
square

NOTES

- Pillow cover is worked in rows and sewn together.
- Color changes are indicated in the pattern.
- Ch 1 at the beginning of the row does not count as a stitch.
- Ch 2 at the beginning of the row counts as hdc.

STITCH CHART



Foundation: Chain in multiples of 6 + 3

ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

ch	chain
sl st	slip stitch
sc	single crochet
hdc	half double crochet
dc	double crochet
tr	treble crochet
dc2tog	double crochet 2 together
bobble	bobble stitch (see note)

STITCH KEY (CHART SYMBOLS)

○	chain (ch)
●	slip stitch (sl st)
+	single crochet (sc)
⊥	half double crochet (hdc)
⊥	double crochet (dc)
⊥	treble crochet (tr)
∨	dc2tog
⊕	bobble stitch (5 dc in same st, remove hook, insert in first dc, yarn over and pull through)
○	petal (see note)

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Rows 1–6 (Bottom Band – Cream):
Ch in multiples of 6 + 3. Work pattern as per chart (rows 1–6).

Rows 7–18 (Daisy Section – Dusty Pink):
Follow chart. Work daisies as shown:
• Flower Center: Work 5 dc in same st (yellow).
• Petals: Work petal stitches around the center (white).
• Stem & Leaves: Work in green as per chart.

Rows 19–24 (Top Band – Cream):
Follow chart. Row 24 creates the scalloped bobble edge.

Finishing:
Fold the piece in half, right sides together. Slip stitch or single crochet the sides together. Insert pillow form and close the last side.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Bobble Stitch (bobble):
Yarn over, insert hook in same stitch, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook. Repeat 4 more times in the same stitch. Yarn over and pull through all 5 loops on hook.

Petal Stitch:
(Ch 3, sl st in next stitch) 5 times around the center. Fasten off.

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Crochet Flower Cushion Tutorial

Make a **16 in (40 cm) square Crochet Flower Cushion** with a dusty pink front panel, cream bobble borders, three appliqué flowers, green stems and leaves, and a solid cream back panel.

Materials

Use **worsted weight (4) cotton or acrylic yarn** in:

- A – Cream**
- B – Dusty Pink**
- C – White**
- D – Yellow**
- E – Green**

You will also need:

- 5.0 mm crochet hook**
- Yarn needle**
- Scissors**
- 16 in (40 cm) pillow form**

Abbreviations US Terms

ch = chain

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

st/sts = stitch/stitches

yo = yarn over

rep = repeat

Step 1: Make the Front Panel

Use **Color B – Dusty Pink**.

Ch 51.

Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and across. You should have **50 sts**.

Rows 2–34: Ch 1, turn, sc across.

Fasten off and weave in the end.

This creates the main pink rectangle where the flowers will be sewn later.

Step 2: Make the Cream Bobble Borders

Use **Color A – Cream**.

Make **2 strips**, one for the top and one for the bottom.

Ch 51.

Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and across.

Row 2: Work the bobble row.

To make one bobble: yo, insert hook in next st, draw up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops.

Repeat this 4 more times in the same stitch, until you have 5 partial dc stitches. Yo and pull through all loops on hook. Ch 1 to secure.

Work **1 bobble in each stitch across**.

Fasten off.

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Step 3: Make the Flowers

Make **3 flowers**.

Use **Color C – White** and **Color D – Yellow**.

Flower Center

Use **Color D – Yellow**.

Make a magic ring, ch 1.

Work 6 sc into the ring.

Pull tight and join with sl st.

Fasten off.

Flower Petals

Use **Color C – White**.

Join white yarn in any stitch around the yellow center.

Ch 2, work 2 hdc, ch 2, sl st in the same stitch.

This makes one petal.

Sl st into the next stitch and repeat around until you have **6 petals total**.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Step 4: Make the Green Stems

Make **3 stems**.

Use **Color E – Green**.

Ch 18.

Sl st in the 2nd ch from the hook and across.

Fasten off.

Each stem will be sewn under one flower.

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Step 5: Make the Leaves

Make **6 leaves**.

Use **Color E – Green**.

Ch 10.

Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook, hdc, sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc, sl st.

Fasten off.

Make 6 leaves total, because each flower has **2 leaves**.

Step 6: Assemble the Flower Panel

Place the dusty pink front panel flat.

Sew the **3 white flowers** evenly across the center of the panel.

Sew one green stem under each flower.

Add **2 leaves beside each stem**, one on each side.

Keep the spacing even so the flowers look balanced across the cushion.

Step 7: Attach the Bobble Borders

Sew one cream bobble border to the **top edge** of the pink front panel.

Sew the second cream bobble border to the **bottom edge** of the pink front panel.

Make sure the bobbles face outward and sit neatly along the edges.

Step 8: Make the Back Panel

Use **Color A – Cream**.

Make a solid square the same size as the completed front panel.

You can crochet it in single crochet rows until it measures about **16 in / 40 cm square**.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Step 9: Join the Cushion

Place the front and back panels together with the wrong sides facing each other.

Using **Color A – Cream**, seam 3 sides closed.

Insert the **16 in pillow form**.

Seam the final side closed securely.

Weave in all remaining ends.

Final Result

Your **Crochet Flower Cushion** is ready! You now have a handmade floral pillow with a pink center, cream bobble borders, white flowers, yellow centers, and green leaves — just like the tutorial chart.

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
