

PATCHWORK QUILT BUNNY

TUTORIAL

Step-by-step guide to make a colorful patchwork bunny

MATERIALS

- Assorted cotton fabrics
- Batting (quilt wadding)
- Backing fabric
- Embroidery floss (for details)
- Appliqué thread
- Needles
- Fabric scissors
- Pins
- Fabric glue (optional)
- Template (full size shown)

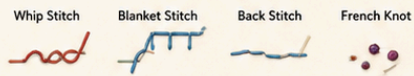

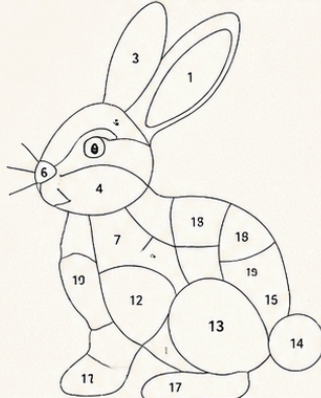
MAIN METHODS USED

- Appliqué (raw edge)
- Quilt As You Go (hand or machine)
- Whip stitch / Blanket stitch
- Back stitch (for details)
- French knots (for flower centers)
- Hand quilting

STITCH GUIDE



1 FULL SIZE TEMPLATE (Measurements in cm)



- 1 Ear outer - 6.5 x 2.5
- 2 Ear inner - 5.5 x 2
- 3 Head top - 4 x 3
- 4 Face - 4 x 3
- 5 Cheek - 3.5 x 2
- 6 Nose - 1 x 0.8
- 7 Body top - 4 x 3
- 8 Back - 5 x 4
- 9 Chest - 3 x 3
- 10 Front leg top - 3 x 2
- 11 Front leg bottom - 3 x 2
- 12 Belly - 4 x 4
- 13 Flower circle - Ø 5.5
- 14 Tail - Ø 2.5
- 15 Back leg top - 3.5 x 2.5
- 16 Back leg bottom - 3 x 2
- 17 Ground paw - 3.5 x 1.5
- 18 Small filler pieces
- 19 (Adjust as needed)

2 CUTTING

- Cut all pieces using the template.
- Add 0.3 cm seam allowance if you prefer to turn edges.
- You can also use raw edge appliqué (recommended).



3 ARRANGE & APPLIQUÉ

Arrange all pieces on the background (light fabric).
Glue baste or pin in place.

Appliqué using whip stitch or blanket stitch.

Start from the center and work outward.



4 EMBROIDER DETAILS

- Eye: Satin stitch or small fabric piece
- Nose: Satin stitch
- Whiskers: Back stitch
- Flowers: French knots for centers, straight stitch for petals and leaves



5 QUILTING

Layer: Top (bunny) + batting + backing.

Quilt around the bunny and inside some patches (echo quilting or in-the-ditch).

Use small stitches for a soft finish.



6 BINDING

Cut binding strips 4 cm wide.

Sew strips together, press in half.

Bind the edge with hand stitch for a beautiful finish.



7 FINISHED!

Your patchwork bunny is ready!

Perfect for spring décor, bags, cushions or wall hangings.



TIPS

- Use small, neat stitches.
- Press your pieces before appliqué.
- Play with colors and fabric textures!



QUILT AS YOU GO (Optional)

Quilt each section before attaching the next.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS



PATCHWORK RABBIT SEWING PATTERN

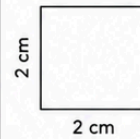
Includes seam allowance

- CUTTING LINE
- - - SEAM ALLOWANCE
(1/4 inch / 0.6 cm)

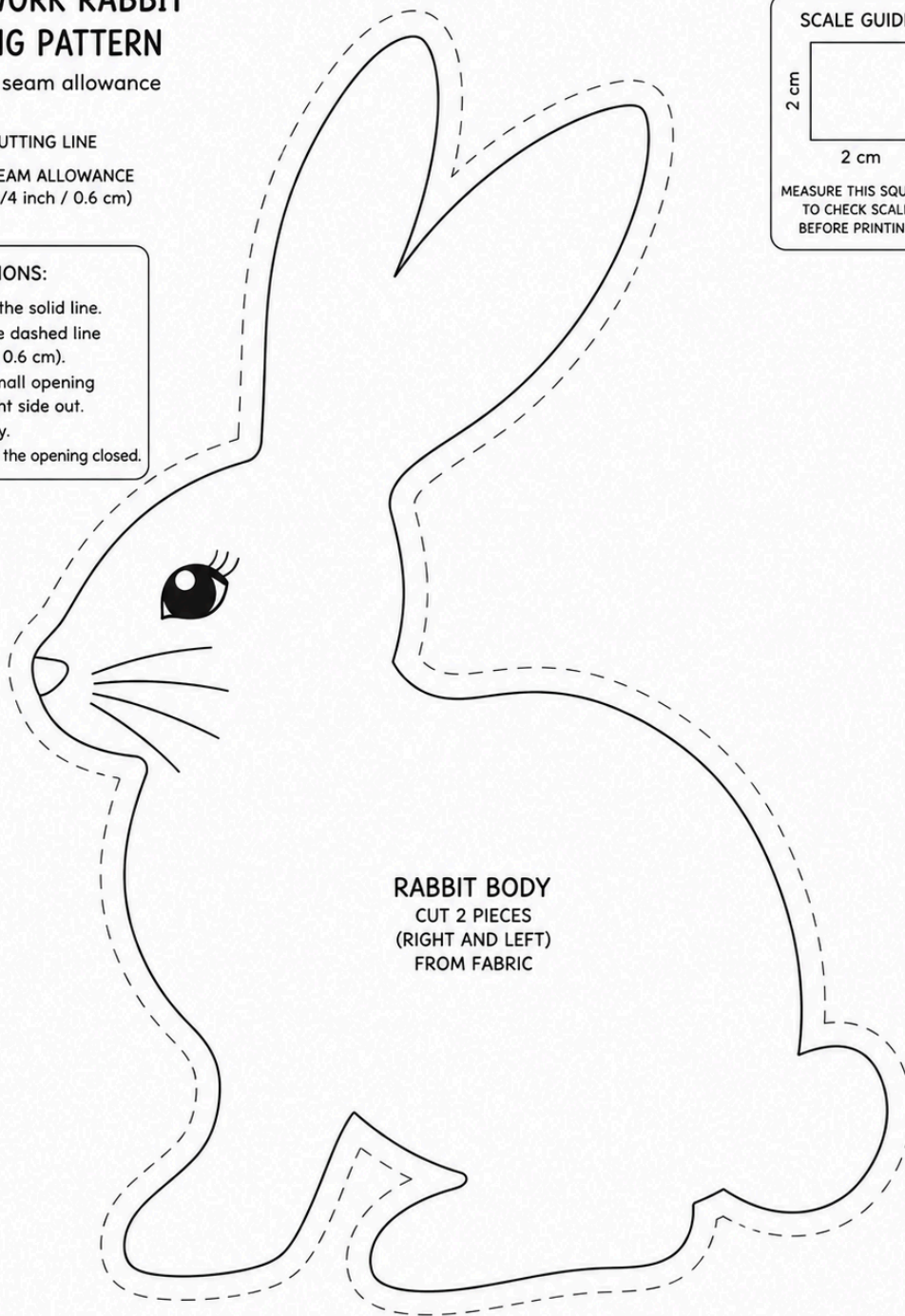
INSTRUCTIONS:

- Cut along the solid line.
- Sew on the dashed line (1/4 inch / 0.6 cm).
- Leave a small opening to turn right side out.
- Stuff softly.
- Hand stitch the opening closed.

Patchwork Quilt Bunny Tutorial

This Patchwork Quilt Bunny Tutorial teaches you how to make a colorful appliqué bunny from start to finish. The finished bunny measures approximately 24 cm high x 18 cm wide.

Materials

You will need assorted cotton fabrics in colors such as yellow, orange, pink, red, purple, blue, turquoise, green, beige, and brown.

You will also need quilt batting, backing fabric, embroidery floss, appliqué thread, needles, fabric scissors, pins, optional fabric glue, and a full-size bunny template.

Step 1: Prepare the Bunny Template

Print or draw the bunny template at full size. The main finished measurement should be about 24 cm tall and 18 cm wide.

Divide the bunny into separate patchwork sections: ears, head, face, cheeks, nose, body, legs, belly, tail, flower pieces, and small filler pieces.

Label each section before cutting so you do not lose the correct placement.

Step 2: Cut the Fabric Pieces

Place each template piece on the chosen fabric color and cut carefully.

Add about 0.3 cm seam allowance if you want to turn the edges under.

For raw-edge appliqué, you can cut exactly on the line.

Use different colors and prints to create a bright patchwork effect.

Step 3: Arrange the Pieces

Lay the backing fabric flat.

Place the bunny pieces on top, starting from the center and working outward.

Arrange the colors so they feel balanced. Try not to place too many similar colors next to each other.

Pin or lightly glue each piece in place.

Step 4: Appliqué the Bunny

Stitch each patchwork piece onto the background fabric.

Use whip stitch or blanket stitch around the edges.

Work slowly and keep your stitches small and neat.

Begin with the center pieces, then continue toward the ears, legs, body, and tail.

Step 5: Add Embroidered Details

Use satin stitch for the eye or add a small black fabric piece.

Make the nose with satin stitch.

Use back stitch for the whiskers and mouth details.

For the flower centers, make French knots. For petals and leaves, use straight stitches.

Step 6: Add the Quilt Layers

Layer the project in this order:

Top bunny appliqué fabric, quilt batting, and backing fabric.

Pin or baste the layers together.

Make sure everything is smooth before quilting.

Step 7: Quilt the Bunny

Quilt around the outside edge of the bunny.

Then quilt inside some patchwork sections.

You can use echo quilting or small in-the-ditch stitches.

Hand quilting gives a soft handmade look, but machine quilting also works well.

Step 8: Bind the Edge

Cut binding strips about 4 cm wide.

Sew the strips together and press them in half.

Attach the binding around the edge of the project.

Finish by hand stitching the back side for a clean look.

Step 9: Care Instructions

Hand wash gently.

Do not bleach.

Dry flat.

Use a warm iron only if needed.

Do not tumble dry.

Final Use Ideas 🌻

Your patchwork quilt bunny is ready!

You can use it for spring décor, Easter decorations, cushions, tote bags, wall hangings, nursery décor, or handmade gifts.

Use small neat stitches, press the fabric before appliqué, and have fun mixing colors and textures.
