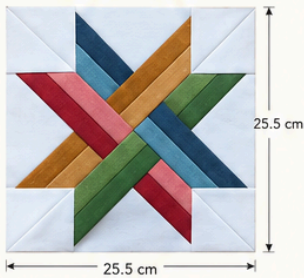


WOVEN STAR QUILT BLOCK – STEP BY STEP TUTORIAL

USING STRIP-PIECING METHOD (ALL MEASUREMENTS IN CM)

1. FINISHED SIZE



2. MATERIALS

- 100% Cotton Quilting Fabric
- Coordinating colors (7 colors shown)
- Thread to match
- Rotary cutter, mat & ruler
- Sewing machine
- Iron & ironing board
- Pins or fabric clips

RECOMMENDED FABRICS:
Medium weight quilting cotton.
Pre-wash and iron before cutting.

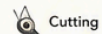
3. CUTTING CHART (STRIP-PIECING)

Cut strips the full width of fabric (WOF ~ 110 cm).
All strips are 3.8 cm wide.

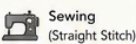
	Dark Blue	2 strips	25.5 cm long
	Medium Blue	2 strips	25.5 cm long
	Green	2 strips	25.5 cm long
	Mustard/Gold	2 strips	25.5 cm long
	Dark Red	2 strips	25.5 cm long
	Pink	2 strips	25.5 cm long
	Background (White)	4 squares	9.5 cm x 9.5 cm

METHODS LEGEND

Key sewing & quilting methods used in this project.



Seam Allowance
0.6 cm



Pressing
(Open or to one side)



Trimming
(Squaring up)

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 SEW PAIRS – MAKE STRIP UNITS

Take two strips of the **SAME** color.

Place right sides together and sew along the long edge.

Use 0.6 cm seam allowance.

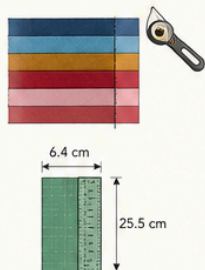


Press open or to one side.

Repeat for all 7 colors.
You will have 7 strip units
(each unit 6.4 cm wide x 25.5 cm long).

4.2 CUT STRIP UNITS

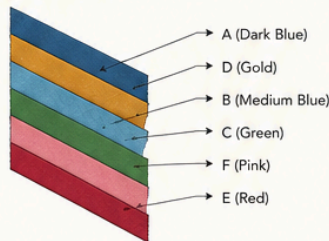
From each strip unit,
cut (1) strip 6.4 cm wide.



You will have 7 strips,
each 6.4 cm x 25.5 cm.

4.3 ARRANGE THE STRIPS

Arrange the 7 strips diagonally as shown (from top to bottom):
A, D, B, C, F, E
(follow the color order in the final block).



QUILTING BASICS (US STYLE)

- Always use 0.6 cm (1/4") seam allowance unless stated otherwise.
- Press seams as you go.
- Measure twice, cut once.
- Use a quilting ruler and rotary cutter for accuracy.

4.4 SEW STRIPS TOGETHER

Sew the strips together along the long edges in the arranged order.

Pin at the intersections to keep everything aligned.

Press seams open or to one side.



4.5 SQUARE UP THE UNIT

Place the unit on your cutting mat.

Trim the sides to make a square 25.5 cm x 25.5 cm.

Use a large square ruler to trim corner-to-corner if needed.



4.6 ADD BACKGROUND CORNERS

Take the 4 white squares (9.5 cm x 9.5 cm).

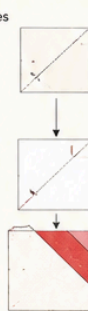
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side.

Place one square on each corner of the unit, right sides together.

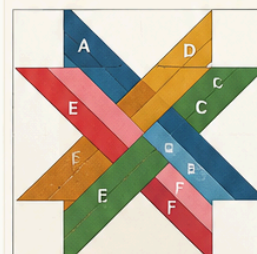
Sew on the drawn line.

Trim 0.6 cm away from the seam.

Press the corners outward.



BLOCK DIAGRAM (LAYOUT OVERVIEW)



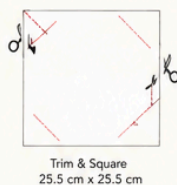
Color Order (top to bottom strips):
A (Dark Blue), D (Gold), B (Medium Blue),
C (Green), F (Pink), E (Red)

4.7 FINAL BLOCK

Your Woven Star block is complete!

Square up to 25.5 cm x 25.5 cm if needed.

Press well.



QUILTING TIPS

- Accuracy in cutting makes a perfect block.
- Use starch for crisp seams.
- Press, don't iron back and forth.
- Chain piece the strip pairs to save time.
- Keep your strips in order as you sew.

FINISHING IDEAS

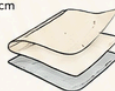


Make multiple blocks and set them:

- On point
- Side by side
- With sashing
- In a sampler quilt

BATTING & BACKING (FOR A QUILT)

- **Batting:** same size as quilt top.
- **Backing:** at least 10 cm larger on all sides.
- **Baste – Quilt – Bind.**



BINDING

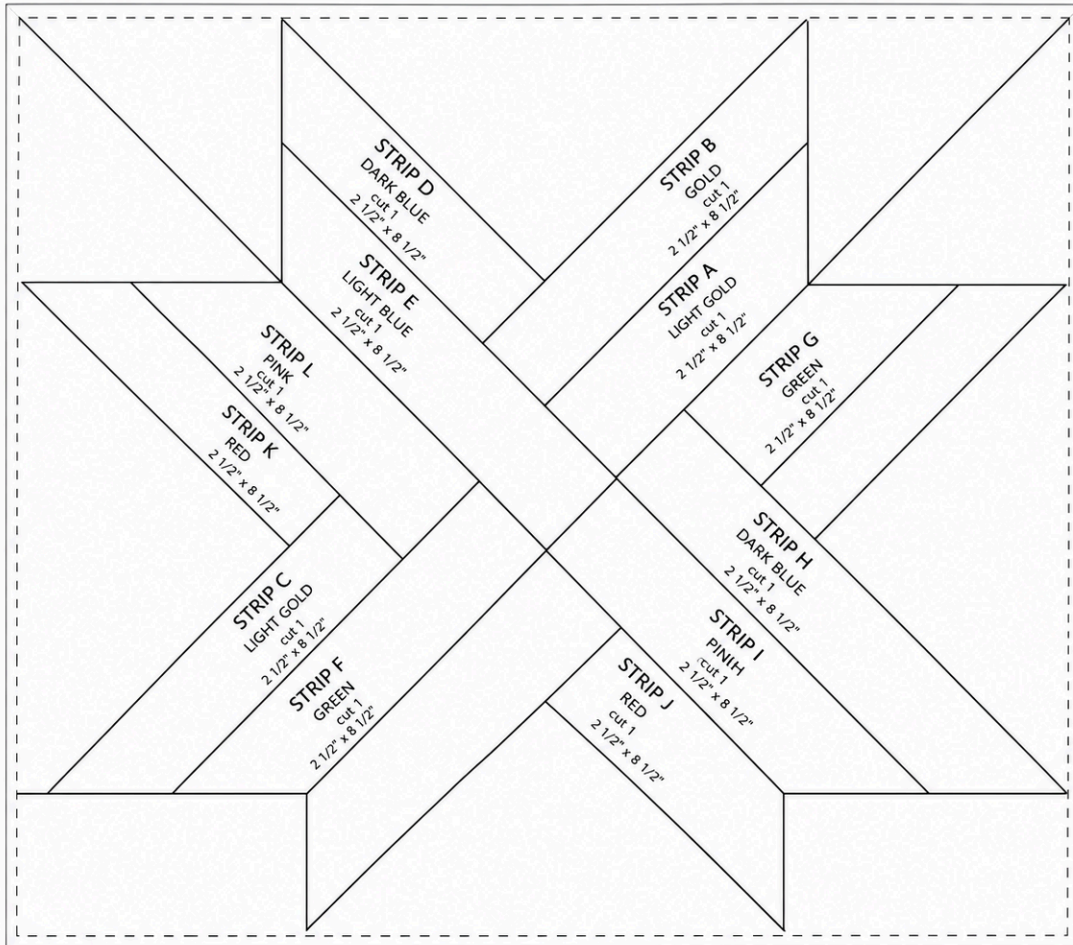
- Cut binding strips 6.3 cm wide.
- Join ends with 45° angle.
- Sew to quilt, fold & hand or machine stitch to the back.



WOVEN STAR QUILT BLOCK TEMPLATE

includes 1/4" (6 mm) seam allowance

SEAM ALLOWANCE
1/4" (6 mm)



INSTRUCTIONS:

- Cut each strip the size indicated (includes 1/4" seam allowance).
- Sew strips together following the color layout above.
- Press seams open or to the side.

Woven Star Quilt Block – Step by Step Tutorial ★

The Woven Star Quilt Block is a colorful strip-pieced quilt block finished at 25.5 cm x 25.5 cm, using a simple strip-piecing method and a 0.6 cm seam allowance.

Finished Size

The finished block measures 25.5 cm x 25.5 cm.

This tutorial uses centimeters, but the sewing style follows a traditional U.S. quilting approach, including accurate cutting, pressing as you go, and trimming the block square at the end.

Materials

You will need:

**100% cotton quilting fabric
Coordinating fabrics in 7 colors
White background fabric
Matching thread
Rotary cutter
Cutting mat
Quilting ruler
Sewing machine
Iron and ironing board
Pins or fabric clips**

Use medium-weight quilting cotton. Pre-wash and press the fabrics before cutting for best results.

Cutting Chart

Cut all strips across the full width of fabric. All color strips should be 3.8 cm wide.

Cut:

**Dark Blue: 2 strips, 25.5 cm long
Medium Blue: 2 strips, 25.5 cm long
Green: 2 strips, 25.5 cm long
Mustard/Gold: 2 strips, 25.5 cm long
Dark Red: 2 strips, 25.5 cm long**

Pink: 2 strips, 25.5 cm long

White Background: 4 squares, 9.5 cm x 9.5 cm

Step 1: Sew Matching Strip Pairs

Take two strips of the same color.

Place them right sides together and sew along the long edge using a 0.6 cm seam allowance.

Press the seam open or to one side.

Repeat this process for all 7 colors.

When finished, you should have 7 strip units, each measuring approximately 6.4 cm wide x 25.5 cm long.

Step 2: Cut the Strip Units

From each sewn strip unit, cut one piece measuring 6.4 cm x 25.5 cm.

Keep your cuts straight and accurate.

You should now have 7 long strip units ready to arrange into the woven star design.

Step 3: Arrange the Color Strips

Arrange the strips diagonally in this order:

A – Dark Blue

D – Mustard/Gold

B – Medium Blue

C – Green

F – Pink

E – Dark Red

Follow the same visual direction shown in the block diagram so the colors appear woven through each other.

Step 4: Sew the Strips Together

Sew the arranged strips together along the long edges.

Pin or clip at the intersections to keep everything aligned.

Sew slowly and use the same 0.6 cm seam allowance throughout.

Press the seams open or to one side after sewing.

You will now have one larger diagonal strip unit.

Step 5: Square Up the Unit

Place the sewn unit on your cutting mat.

Use a large quilting ruler to trim it into a square measuring 25.5 cm x 25.5 cm.

Trim carefully from corner to corner as needed.

Accuracy at this step helps the final star block look clean and balanced.

Step 6: Add the White Background Corners

Take the four white squares measuring 9.5 cm x 9.5 cm.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each white square.

Place one white square on each corner of the strip unit, right sides together.

Sew directly on the drawn diagonal line.

Trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 0.6 cm seam allowance.

Press the white corners outward.

Step 7: Finish the Block

After adding all four corners, press the entire block well.

Square up the finished block to 25.5 cm x 25.5 cm if needed.

Your Woven Star Quilt Block is now complete.

Quilting Tips

Use accurate cutting for a cleaner final block.

Press as you go, but avoid stretching the fabric.

Use starch for crisper seams.

Keep your strip order organized before sewing.

Chain piecing can save time if you are making several blocks.

Always measure twice and cut once.

Finishing Ideas

You can make one block as a decorative panel.

You can sew multiple blocks together for a full quilt.

Try placing blocks side by side for a colorful woven design.

You can also use this block for cushions, table runners, wall hangings, or sampler quilts.

Batting, Backing, and Binding

For a quilt, use batting the same size as your quilt top.

Cut the backing at least 10 cm larger on all sides.

Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top.

Baste, quilt, and bind.

For binding, cut strips 6.3 cm wide.

Join binding strips with 45-degree seams, sew to the quilt, fold, and finish by hand or machine.

Enjoy your quilting!
