US CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
 sl st = slip stitch
 sc = single crochet
 hdc = half double crochet
 dc = double crochet
 tr = treble crochet
 inc = increase (2 sts in same st)
 dec = decrease (sc2tog)
 st(s) = stitch(es)
 rep = repeat
 FO = fasten off



FINISHED SIZE

Approx. 11–12 inches

MATERIALS

Medium Weight (4) Cotton Yarn
 Colors:

- Background: Cream
- Border: Light Tan
- Hen: White, Light Gray, Red, Yellow (beak/legs)
- Rooster: Brown, Rust, Tan, Dark Green, Red, Yellow (beak/legs)
- Grass: Olive Green

- 5.0 mm (H) Crochet Hook
- Yarn Needle
- Scissors

1 HEART BACKGROUND

Make 2 identical heart panels (front and back).

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Make another panel the same way.

2 BORDER

Join border color in any stitch.

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3 ROOSTER (Right Side)

BODY (Brown)				WING (Tan)		TAIL FEATHERS (Dark Green)		
HEAD & NECK		COMB & WATTLE (Red)		BEAK (Yellow)	EYE	LEGS & FEET (Yellow)		

4 HEN (Left Side)

BODY (White/Light Gray)				WING (Light Gray)		TAIL FEATHERS (Light Gray & White)		
HEAD & NECK		COMB & WATTLE (Red)		BEAK (Yellow)	EYE	LEGS & FEET (Yellow)		

6 ASSEMBLY

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TIPS

- Use stitch markers to keep track of rounds.
- Block your finished piece for a smooth, even shape.
- Adjust hook size for a tighter or looser fabric.
- Have fun and make it your own!

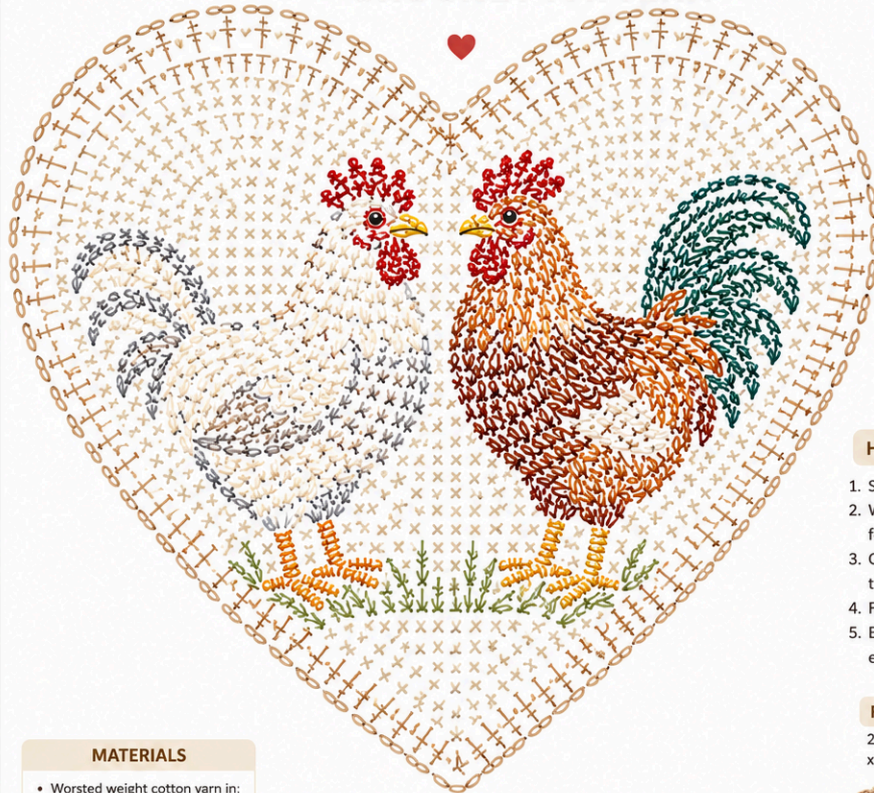


BASIC STITCH GUIDE (US TERMS)

HEART WITH ROOSTER AND HEN CROCHET PATTERN



STITCH LEGEND (US TERMS)

- Chain (ch)
- Slip Stitch (sl st)
- × Single Crochet (sc)
- ┆ Half Double Crochet (hdc)
- ┆ Double Crochet (dc)
- ┆ Treble Crochet (tr)
- ∨ 2 sc increase (2 sc in same st)
- Λ 2 dc together (dc2tog)
- ⌋ 3 dc cluster (3 dc in same st)

HOW TO MAKE

1. Start from the center bottom of the heart.
2. Work the heart shape in the round following the chart.
3. Change colors as indicated in the chart to create the rooster, hen, and details.
4. Fasten off, weave in ends.
5. Blocking is recommended to even out the stitches.

FINISHED SIZE (approx.)

23 cm (9 in) wide
x 21 cm (8.3 in) tall

MATERIALS

- Worsted weight cotton yarn in: Cream, Beige, Brown, Tan, Red, Green, Yellow, Orange, Gray
- 4.0 mm (G/6) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

TOOLS

4.0 mm
(G/6)
Crochet Hook

COLOR GUIDE

- Background / Heart: Cream, Beige, Tan
- Hen: White (Cream), Gray, Red, Yellow, Orange
- Rooster: Brown, Tan, Red, Green, Yellow, Orange
- Grass: Green

NOTES

- This pattern is worked in continuous rounds.
- Use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round.
- Colors can be customized to your preference.



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Crochet Heart with Rooster & Hen Complete Tutorial



This Crochet Heart with Rooster & Hen is a handmade decorative crochet project made with a double heart base, a textured border, appliqué rooster and hen pieces, small grass details, and final assembly. The design is worked mostly in US crochet terms, using cotton yarn and a 5.0 mm crochet hook.

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Finished size: approximately 11–12 inches.

Materials

Use medium weight cotton yarn size 4.

Colors needed:

Cream for the heart background

Light tan for the border

White, light gray, red, yellow, and rust for the hen

Brown, rust, tan, dark green, red, yellow, and black for the rooster

Olive green for the grass

You will also need:

5.0 mm crochet hook

Yarn needle

Scissors

Stitch markers

Fiberfill for light stuffing

Black yarn or safety beads for eyes

US Crochet Abbreviations

ch = chain

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

tr = treble crochet

inc = increase, 2 stitches in the same stitch

dec = decrease, single crochet 2 together

st / sts = stitch / stitches

rep = repeat

FO = fasten off

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Step 1: Crochet the Heart Background

Make 2 identical heart panels in cream yarn. One will be the front panel and the other will be the back panel.

Begin with ch 4. Slip stitch into the first chain to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3. Work 15 dc into the ring. Slip stitch to the top of ch 3. You should have 16 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3. Work 2 dc in each stitch around. Slip stitch to close. You should have 32 dc.

Round 3: Ch 3. Work 2 dc in each stitch around again. Slip stitch to close. You should have 48 dc.

Round 4: Ch 3. Work 2 dc in the next stitch, then 2 dc in the next stitch. Repeat around. Slip stitch to close. You should have 64 dc.

Round 5: Shape the heart top. Ch 2. Work dc in the next 18 stitches, then work next stitch repeat around, following the curve shown in the chart. Keep the top rounded and slightly dipped in the center.

Continue shaping until the panel forms a heart. Use stitch markers to keep the center top point and bottom point clear.

Make a second heart panel the same way.

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Step 2: Crochet the Border

Join the light tan border yarn in any stitch around the heart.

Round 1: Ch 1. Work sc evenly around the entire heart. At the top center point, make 3 sc. At the bottom point, make 3 sc.

Round 2: Ch 3. This counts as dc. Work dc in the same stitch, skip next stitch, then dc in the next stitch. Repeat around to create a textured border.

Round 3: Ch 1. Work sc in each dc and into each chain-1 space around.

Optional Round 4: Work a shell stitch border. Make 5 dc in the next stitch, skip next stitch, sl st in the next stitch, skip next stitch. Repeat around.

Fasten off and weave in the ends.

Step 3: Crochet the Rooster Body

Use brown yarn.

Ch 4 and slip stitch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 2. Work 11 hdc into the ring. Slip stitch to close. You should have 12 hdc.

Round 2: Ch 2. Work 2 hdc in each stitch around. Slip stitch to close. You should have 24 hdc.

Round 3: Ch 2. Work hdc in the next stitch, 2 hdc in the next stitch. Repeat around. Slip stitch to close. You should have 36 hdc.

Round 4: Ch 2. Work hdc around without increasing for 3 rounds. This gives the rooster body a rounded shape.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

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Step 4: Crochet the Rooster Wing

Use tan yarn.

Ch 10. Starting in the second chain from the hook, work hdc across.

Ch 1 and turn. Work sc across.

Fasten off and sew the wing onto the rooster body.

Step 5: Crochet the Rooster Tail Feathers

Use dark green yarn.

Make 4 or 5 feathers in different lengths.

For each feather: Ch 18. Starting in the second chain from the hook, work hdc across.

Slip stitch down one side of the chain to create a slight curve.

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Sew the feathers behind the rooster body, arranging them in a fan shape.

Step 6: Crochet the Rooster Head and Neck

Join yarn at the top of the body.

Ch 2. Work hdc around the small head area, shaping a rounded neck and head.

Stuff lightly before closing.

Fasten off and secure the head to the body.

Step 7: Crochet the Rooster Comb, Wattle, Beak, Eye, Legs and Feet

For the comb, use red yarn. Ch 4, then work 3 dc in the second chain from hook, sl st, and repeat 4 or 5 times to form small bumps.

For the wattle, use red yarn. Ch 4, work 3 dc in the second chain, then sl st. Make 2 small pieces and sew under the beak.

For the beak, use yellow yarn. Ch 6. Starting in the second chain from the hook, work sl st, hdc, sl st. Sew to the face.

For the eye, embroider with black yarn or sew on a small black bead.

For the legs, use yellow yarn. Ch 10. Slip stitch in the second chain from hook and in each chain across.

For the toes, ch 5 for each toe and slip stitch back down. Make 3 toes per foot. Make 2 legs and sew them to the body.

Step 8: Crochet the Hen Body

Use white or light gray yarn.

Ch 4 and slip stitch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 2. Work 11 hdc into the ring. Slip stitch to close. You should have 12 hdc.

Round 2: Ch 2. Work 2 hdc in each stitch around. Slip stitch to close. You should have 24 hdc.

Round 3: Ch 2. Work hdc in the next stitch, 2 hdc in the next stitch. Repeat around. Slip stitch to close. You should have 36 hdc.

Round 4: Ch 2. Work hdc around without increasing for 3 rounds.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Step 9: Crochet the Hen Wing and Tail Feathers

For the wing, use light gray yarn.

Ch 10. Starting in the second chain from hook, work hdc across.

Ch 1 and turn. Work sc across.

Fasten off and sew to the body.

For the tail feathers, use light gray and white yarn.

Ch 16 for each feather. Work hdc across, then slip stitch down one side to curve the feather.

Make 3 or 4 feathers and sew them behind the hen body.

Step 10: Crochet the Hen Head, Comb, Beak, Eye, Legs and Feet

Make the hen head and neck the same way as the rooster, but slightly smaller.

Use red yarn to make a small comb and wattle.

Use yellow yarn for the beak.

Embroider the eye with black yarn or sew on a small bead.

Make the legs and feet the same way as the rooster, using yellow yarn.

Sew all pieces securely to the hen body.

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Step 11: Crochet the Grass

Use olive green yarn.

Make several small grass pieces.

For each piece: Ch 12. Starting in the second chain from hook, work sl st in the second chain from hook, then hdc across.

Slip stitch down the side to form a curved grass blade.

Make smaller grass pieces by chaining fewer stitches.

Sew the grass pieces along the bottom inside area of the heart.

Step 12: Assembly

Place the front heart panel flat.

Arrange the rooster on the right side of the heart.

Arrange the hen on the left side of the heart.

Pin all pieces in place before sewing.

Sew the hen, rooster, wings, tails, combs, wattles, beaks, legs, feet, and grass securely onto the front heart panel.

Place the second heart panel behind the first panel.

Using light tan yarn, single crochet around both layers together through both panels.

Before closing completely, check the shape and lightly adjust if needed.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Final Tips

Block the finished heart for a smoother shape.

Use stitch markers to keep the top curves and bottom point even.

Adjust hook size if your stitches are too loose or too tight.

Have fun and make it your own with different yarn colors. ❤️
