

CHURCH QUILT BLOCK TUTORIAL

Step-by-Step Guide with Measurements in CM



FINISHED SIZE:
30 cm x 30 cm

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- A Sky Background (light blue)
- B Church Body (light beige)
- C Roof & Cross (dark floral)
- D Window (blue polka dot)
- E Lower Wall (mint floral)
- F Door (yellow floral)
- G Windows (white floral)

TOOLS

- Sewing machine
- Rotary cutter & mat
- Quilting ruler
- Iron & ironing board
- Pins or clips
- Thread
- Fabric marker

FABRIC CUTTING GUIDE (All measurements include 0.7 cm seam allowance)

| PIECE | SIZE (CM) | QUANTITY |
|------------------------|-----------|----------|
| A1, A2, A3 (Sky) | 30 x 8 | 3 |
| A4, A5 (Sides) | 7 x 12.5 | 2 |
| B1 (Church Body) | 7 x 6 | 1 |
| B2 (Church Roof Base) | 14 x 6 | 1 |
| B3 (Steeple Sides) | 3 x 6 | 2 |
| B4 (Steeple Top) | 5 x 3 | 1 |
| C1 (Roof) | 14 x 6 | 1 |
| C2 (Cross Vertical) | 2.5 x 6.5 | 1 |
| C3 (Cross Horizontal) | 5 x 2.5 | 1 |
| D (Window) | 3 x 5 | 1 |
| E1 (Lower Wall Top) | 30 x 3 | 1 |
| E2 (Lower Wall Bottom) | 30 x 7 | 1 |
| F (Door) | 6 x 8.5 | 1 |
| G (Windows) | 3 x 6 | 2 |

CONSTRUCTION STEPS

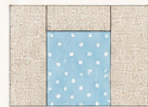
1 PREPARE PIECES

Cut all fabric pieces according to the cutting guide above. Mark wrong side of fabric using a fabric marker.



2 SEW CHURCH BODY

Sew B3 (sides) to each side of B1 (Church Body). Press seams outward. Then sew D (Window) in the center.



3 ADD STEEPLE TOP

Sew B4 (top) above the church body unit. Press seam upward.



4 ADD CROSS

Sew C2 (vertical) and C3 (horizontal) to make the cross. Then sew the cross to the top of the steeple.



6 MAKE ROOF SECTION

Sew C1 (Roof) to B2 (Roof Base). Press seam upward.



5 JOIN CHURCH AND ROOF

Sew the church unit to the roof section. Press seam upward.



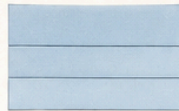
7 ADD SIDE SKY PIECES

Sew A4 and A5 to the sides of the church unit. Press seams outward.



8 ADD TOP SKY STRIPS

Sew A1, A2, and A3 together vertically to make the top sky section. Press seams in one direction.



9 ASSEMBLE TOP SECTION

Sew the top sky section to the upper part of the block. Press seam upward.



10 ADD LOWER WALL SECTION

Sew E1 (top strip) and E2 (bottom strip) together. Press seam upward.



11 ADD DOOR AND WINDOWS

Sew F (Door) to the lower wall section. Then sew G (Windows) on each side of the door.

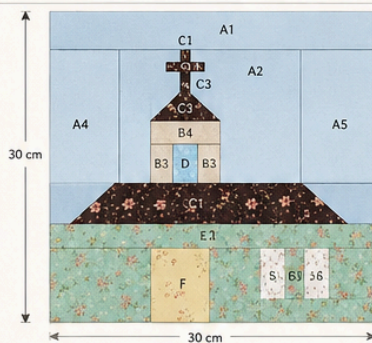


12 JOIN AND FINISH BLOCK

Sew the lower wall section to the bottom of the block. Press seam upward. Your Church Quilt Block is complete! Final size: 30 cm x 30 cm



ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM (30 cm x 30 cm)



TIPS

- Use 100% cotton quilting fabrics.
- Pressing is key to accurate piecing.
- Measure twice, cut once!

QUILTING & FINISHING

1. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing.
2. Baste the layers together.
3. Quilt as desired (straight lines, echo quilting, or free-motion quilting).
4. Square up the block to 30 cm x 30 cm.
5. Bind the edges.



LEGEND - KEY SEWING & QUILTING METHODS

- 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE (0.7 cm)**
Always use 0.7 cm seam allowance.
- PRESS SEAMS**
Press seams as indicated in each step (↑ upward, → to side, ↓ downward).
- CHAIN PIECING**
Sew pieces one after another without cutting thread to save time.
- NESTING SEAMS**
Match seam intersections to reduce bulk.
- SQUARE UP**
Use a ruler to trim block to exact measurements.
- QUILT AS DESIRED**
Straight line, echo, or free-motion quilting.
- BINDING**
Finish edges with 6.5 cm wide binding strips.

CHURCH QUILT BLOCK PAPER PIECING PATTERN

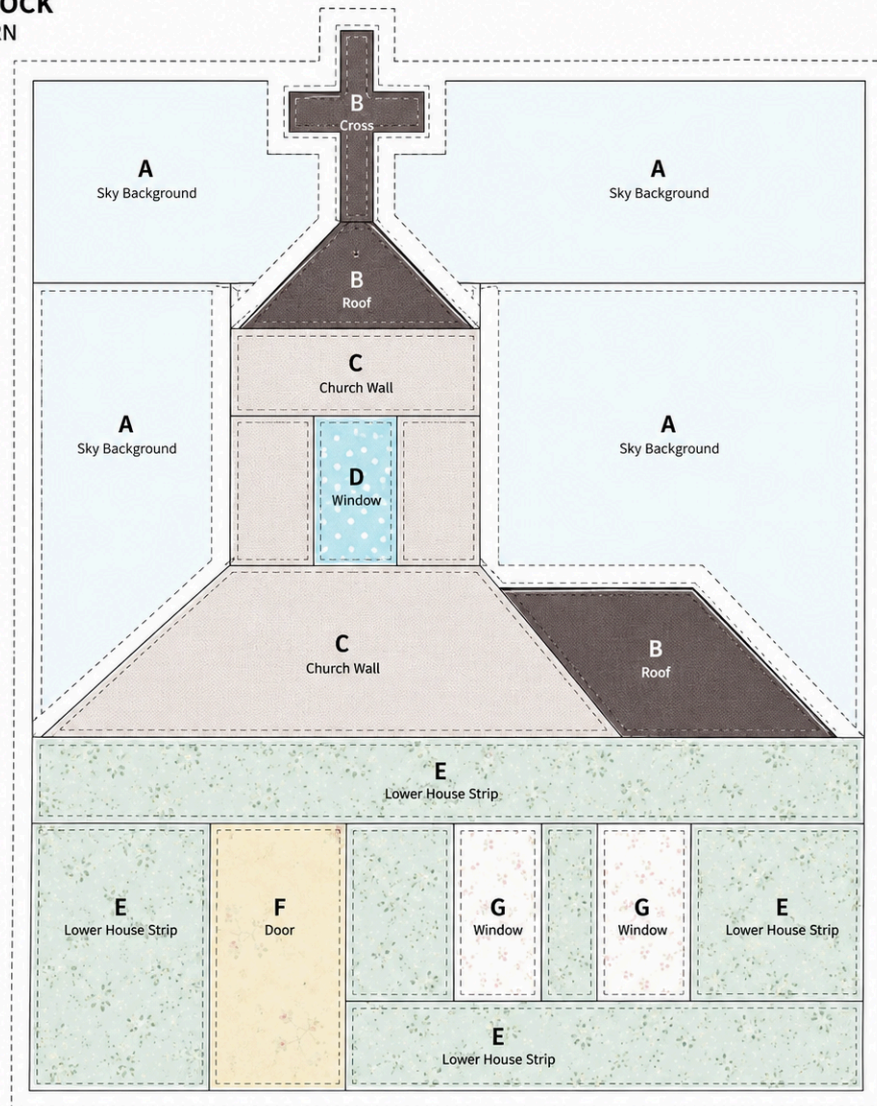
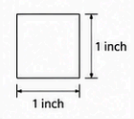
Includes 1/4" (6 mm)

|  | Lower House Strip (Mint Floral) |
|  | Door (Yellow Floral) |
|  | Windows (White Floral) |

NOTES

- Pattern includes 1/4" (6 mm) seam allowance.
- Use fabric guide as reference.
- Cut fabrics slightly larger than the pattern pieces.
- Paper piece following the numbered sections.

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Church Quilt Block Tutorial: Complete Step-by-Step Guide in CM

This Church Quilt Block Tutorial creates a finished quilt block measuring 30 cm x 30 cm. All measurements include a 0.7 cm seam allowance, which is equal to approximately 1/4 inch, commonly used by quilters in the United States.

Finished Size and Fabric Requirements

Finished block size: 30 cm x 30 cm

You will need:

A – Sky Background: light blue fabric

B – Church Body: light beige fabric

C – Roof and Cross: dark floral fabric

D – Window: blue polka dot fabric

E – Lower Wall: mint floral fabric

F – Door: yellow floral fabric

G – Windows: white floral fabric

Tools needed:

Sewing machine

Rotary cutter and mat

Quilting ruler

Iron and ironing board

Pins or clips

Thread

Fabric marker

Fabric Cutting Guide

Cut the following pieces:

A1, A2, A3 Sky: 30 cm x 8 cm — cut 3

A4, A5 Sky Sides: 7 cm x 12.5 cm — cut 2

B1 Church Body: 7 cm x 6 cm — cut 1

B2 Roof Base: 14 cm x 6 cm — cut 1

B3 Steeple Sides: 3 cm x 6 cm — cut 2

B4 Steeple Top: 5 cm x 3 cm — cut 1

C1 Roof: 14 cm x 6 cm — cut 1

C2 Cross Vertical: 2.5 cm x 6.5 cm — cut 1

C3 Cross Horizontal: 5 cm x 2.5 cm — cut 1

D Window: 3 cm x 5 cm — cut 1

E1 Lower Wall Top: 30 cm x 3 cm — cut 1

E2 Lower Wall Bottom: 30 cm x 7 cm — cut 1

F Door: 6 cm x 8.5 cm — cut 1

G Windows: 3 cm x 6 cm — cut 2

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Prepare All Fabric Pieces

Before sewing, cut every piece according to the measurements above.

Place the pieces in groups: sky, church body, roof, cross, lower wall, door, and windows.

Mark the wrong side of the fabric if needed, especially on pieces that may be confusing.

Use a consistent 0.7 cm seam allowance throughout the entire project.

Press your fabrics before starting so each piece lies flat and straight.

Sew the Church Body

Take piece B1, the church body.

Sew one B3 steeple side to the left side of B1.

Sew the second B3 steeple side to the right side of B1.

Press the seams outward.

Now sew piece D, the blue window, in the center of the church body section.

Press carefully so the window stays neat and flat.

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Add the Steeple Top

Take piece B4, the steeple top.

Place it above the church body section.

Sew B4 to the top of the church body.

Press the seam upward.

This creates the basic center structure of the church.

Add the Cross

Take piece C2, the vertical cross piece.

Take piece C3, the horizontal cross piece.

Sew C3 across C2 to create the cross shape.

Then sew the finished cross to the top of the steeple.

Press gently, taking care not to stretch the small pieces.

Make the Roof Section

Take piece C1, the roof fabric.

Take piece B2, the roof base.

Sew C1 to B2.

Press the seam upward.

This forms the main roof section of the church.

Join the Church and Roof

Place the church body unit on top of the roof section.

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Sew the church body to the roof.

Press the seam upward.

Make sure the steeple is centered before sewing.

Your church shape will now be clearly visible.

Add the Side Sky Pieces

Take pieces A4 and A5.

Sew A4 to the left side of the church unit.

Sew A5 to the right side of the church unit.

Press the seams outward.

These pieces create the sky around the church.

Add the Top Sky Strips

Take pieces A1, A2, and A3.

Sew them together to form the upper sky section.

Press all seams in one direction.

Then sew this sky section to the top of the church block.

Press the seam upward.

Assemble the Top Section

Now the upper part of the quilt block should include the sky, cross, steeple, church body, and roof.

Check that the block lies flat.

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Trim lightly only if needed.

Do not over-trim at this stage.

Keep the shape square and balanced.

Make the Lower Wall Section

Take piece E1, the lower wall top strip.

Take piece E2, the lower wall bottom strip.

Sew E1 to E2.

Press the seam upward.

This creates the floral lower wall area at the bottom of the block.

Add the Door and Windows

Take piece F, the door.

Sew it into the lower wall section.

Then take the two G window pieces.

Sew one window on each side of the door, following the layout from the tutorial image.

Press all seams carefully.

Make sure the door and windows are straight.

Join and Finish the Block

Sew the lower wall section to the bottom of the church block.

Press the seam upward.

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Square up the block to 30 cm x 30 cm.

Your Church Quilt Block is complete.

Quilting and Finishing

Layer the quilt top with batting and backing.

Baste the layers together.

Quilt as desired using straight lines, echo quilting, or free-motion quilting.

Square the block again to 30 cm x 30 cm.

Bind the edges to finish your project.

Enjoy quilting! 

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
