



# 3D Flower Granny Square



## Step-by-Step Crochet Tutorial



### FINISHED SIZE

Approx. 6.5 x 6.5 in  
(16.5 x 16.5 cm)



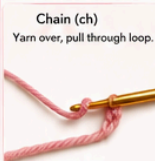
### MATERIALS

- Worsted weight cotton yarn  
Colors:  
A - Dusty Pink (main flower)  
B - Light Pink (accents)  
C - Cream (petals)  
D - Green (leaves)
- 4.0 mm (G) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

### ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

ch	chain
sl st	slip stitch
sc	single crochet

### BASIC STITCHES (US TERMS)



**Chain (ch)**  
Yarn over, pull through loop.



**Slip Stitch (sl st)**  
Insert hook, yarn over, pull through both loops on hook.



**Single Crochet (sc)**  
Insert hook, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through both loops.



**Half Double Crochet (hdc)**  
Yarn over, insert hook, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops.



**Double Crochet (dc)**  
Yarn over, insert hook, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through last 2 loops.



**Treble Crochet (tr)**  
Yarn over twice, insert hook, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops (3 times).

### STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

#### 1 FLOWER CENTER (Make 2)



With A, ch 24.  
Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across. [23 sts]  
Roll the strip into a spiral and stitch the base to secure.

#### 2 INNER PETALS (Make 1)



With A, ch 3.  
Round 1: 11 dc in 3rd ch from hook. Join with sl st to first dc. [11 dc]  
Fasten off.

#### 3 MIDDLE PETALS (Make 1)



With B, ch 3.  
Round 1: (2 dc in next st, dc in next st) around. [16 dc] Join with sl st.  
Fasten off.

#### 4 OUTER PETALS (Make 1)



With C, ch 3.  
Round 1: (2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts) around. [21 dc] Join with sl st.  
Fasten off.

#### 5 LEAVES (Make 4)



With D, ch 10.  
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next 2 ch, dc in next 4 ch, hdc in next 2 ch, sc in last ch.  
Fasten off leaving a long tail.

#### 6 ARRANGE FLOWER



Layer the pieces:  
Center -> Inner petals  
-> Middle petals -> Outer petals.  
Sew through the base to hold all layers together.

#### 7 ATTACH LEAVES



Sew 4 leaves between the outer petals, spaced evenly.

#### 8 ROUND 1 (Base)



With B, ch 4, join with sl st to first ch to form a ring.  
(Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ring.  
Repeat 3 more times.  
Join. [4 corner spaces]

#### 9 ROUND 2



Sl st to corner ch-2 sp.  
Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in same sp.  
(3 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp) around.  
Join.  
[8 clusters, 4 ch-2 sps]

#### 10 ROUND 3



Sl st to corner ch-2 sp.  
Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in same sp.  
(3 dc in next 3 sts, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp) around.  
Join.

#### 11 ROUND 4 (Lacy Border)



Sl st to any ch-2 sp.  
Ch 1, sc in same sp, (ch 5, sc in next ch-2 sp) around.  
This creates the lace loops.  
Join. Fasten off.

#### 12 FASTEN OFF & WEAVE IN ENDS



Weave in all ends using a yarn needle.  
Block gently to shape if needed.

### COLOR GUIDE



### BACK VIEW (Optional)



Sewing the leaves and petals well will give a clean back.

### TIPS

- ♥ Use cotton yarn for better stitch definition.
- ♥ Keep stitches consistent.
- ♥ Block the square for a flat, even shape.
- ♥ Great for blankets, pillows, bags, and more!

### CROCHET METHODS USED



**Magic Ring:**  
create an adjustable loop for the center.



**Working in the Round:** join each round with a sl st.



**Clusters**  
(3 dc together): work multiple dc in the same stitch.



**Chain Spaces:** create lace and corners.



**Layering & Sewing Pieces:** assemble for 3D effect.



**Weaving in Ends:** use yarn needle to hide all tails.

# ♥ CROCHET FLORAL SQUARE – DIAGRAM & STITCH GUIDE ♥

Beautiful 3D Flower Square with Leaves

## MATERIALS

- Worsted weight cotton yarn in 5 colors:  
Dark pink, Light pink, Cream, Green, Light green
- 4.0 mm (G) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

## STITCH KEY (US TERMS)

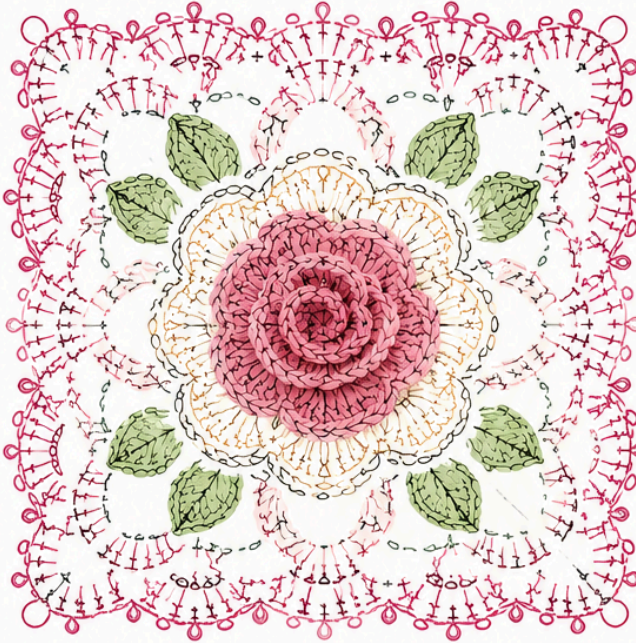
- ch chain
- sl st slip stitch
- + sc single crochet
- ⌣ hdc half double crochet
- ⌣ dc double crochet
- ⌣ tr treble crochet
- ⌣ dtr double treble crochet
- ⊖ 3-dc 3-dc bobble  
(3 double crochet in same stitch, yo and pull through all loops)
- ◇ picot (ch 3, sl st in 3rd chain from hook)
- 🌿 Leaf - see Leaf Diagram below

US TERMS

Skill Level: Intermediate ★★☆☆

Finished Size: Approx. 20 cm / 8 in square

## HOW TO MAKE

- Center Flower**  
Make the flower from the center outwards (Rounds 1-6).
- Leaves**  
Crochet 8 leaves (4 green + 4 light green) and attach around Round 3.
- Petal Layer**  
Work the petal round (Round 4) in cream around the flower.
- Outer Petal Layer**  
Work the next petal round (Round 5) in light pink around the flower.
- Square Border**  
Create the lacy square border (Round 6) in dark pink.

## FLOWER INSTRUCTIONS (CENTER OUT)

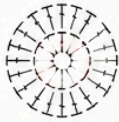
### Round 1

With dark pink yarn. ch 4, sl st to first ch to form ring.  
Ch 3 (counts as dc).  
11 dc in ring.  
Join with sl st.  
(12 dc)



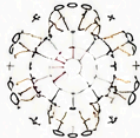
### Round 2

Ch 3, dc in same st.  
2 dc in each st around.  
Join with sl st.  
(24 dc)



### Round 3

Ch 1, sc in same st.  
\* ch 3, skip 1 st, sc in next st \* repeat around.  
Join with sl st.  
(12 ch-3 spaces)



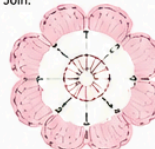
### Round 4

Join cream yarn in any ch-3 space.  
(Sc, hdc, 2 dc, hdc, sc) in same space. \*Skip next sc, repeat in next ch-3 space around.  
Join. (12 petals)



### Round 5

Join light pink yarn in any ch-3 space between petals.  
(Sc, hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc, sc) in space. \*Repeat around.  
Join.



### Round 6 (Border)

Join dark pink yarn. Ch 1, sc in same st, \* ch 5, sc in next st \* around (creates arches).  
In corners: (sc, ch 3, sc) in same space.  
Join and fasten off.



## LEAF DIAGRAM (MAKE 8)

With green or light green yarn



**Row 1:** Ch 8, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 5 ch, 3 sc in last ch. Working on the other side of the chain: sc in next 5 ch, 2 sc in last ch. Join with sl st.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc, (sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc) in corner st, sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc, sl st.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

## ASSEMBLY

- Sew 8 leaves around the flower (as shown in the chart/photo).
- Weave in all ends neatly.
- Block the square gently to shape.

- C 2.75 mm

## TIPS

- ✓ Use cotton yarn for best stitch definition.
- ✓ Blocking helps the square lay flat and even.
- ✓ Change colors to match your style!

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## 3D Flower Granny Square Crochet Tutorial

This **3D Flower Granny Square** is a beautiful crochet project made with layered petals, leaves, and a lacy granny square base. The finished size is approximately **6.5 x 6.5 inches**.

### Materials

Worsted weight cotton yarn:

**A – Dusty Pink** for the main flower

**B – Light Pink** for accents

**C – Cream** for petals

**D – Green** for leaves

You will also need a **4.0 mm G crochet hook**, yarn needle, and scissors.

### Abbreviations US Terms

**ch** chain

**sl st** slip stitch

**sc** single crochet

**hdc** half double crochet

**dc** double crochet

**tr** treble crochet

**sts** stitches

**sp** space

**st** stitch

**ch-2 sp** chain 2 space

**join** close the round with a slip stitch

### Step 1: Flower Center Make 2

Using **Dusty Pink A**, chain **24**.

Starting in the **2nd chain from the hook**, work **1 sc in each chain across**. You should have **23 stitches**.

Roll the strip tightly into a spiral rose shape.

Use a yarn needle and the yarn tail to stitch through the base several times, securing the rose firmly.

Make **2 flower centers** if you want a fuller 3D look, or use one as the main center and one for extra volume.

## Step 2: Inner Petals

Using **Dusty Pink A**, chain **3**.

Round 1: Work **11 dc into the 3rd chain from the hook**.

Join with a **sl st** to the first dc.

Fasten off and weave in the end.

Place this small petal circle behind the spiral flower center.

## Step 3: Middle Petals

Using **Light Pink B**, chain **3**.

Round 1: Work **2 dc in the next stitch, then 1 dc in the next stitch** around.

Continue repeating this pattern until you have **16 dc total**.

Join with a **sl st**.

Fasten off.

This layer should sit behind the inner petals and give the flower more fullness.

## Step 4: Outer Petals

Using **Cream C**, chain **3**.

Round 1: Work **2 dc in the next stitch, then 1 dc in each of the next 2 stitches** around.

Continue until you have **21 dc total**.

Join with a **sl st**.

Fasten off.

This cream layer creates contrast and makes the flower look soft and dimensional.

## Step 5: Leaves Make 4

Using **Green D**, chain **10**.

Starting in the **2nd chain from the hook**, work:

**1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc in each of the next 4 chains, 1 hdc in next 2 chains, 1 sc in last chain.**

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Make **4 leaves**.

Shape each leaf gently with your fingers so it looks pointed and natural.

## Step 6: Arrange the Flower

Layer the flower pieces in this order:

Center rose  
Inner petals  
Middle petals  
Outer petals

Sew through the base of all layers using a yarn needle.

Make sure the flower is centered and secure.

Do not sew too tightly; the petals should still look soft and raised.

## Step 7: Attach the Leaves

Place the **4 green leaves** evenly around the flower.

Sew each leaf between the outer petals.

Keep the leaves slightly visible from the front.

Secure all yarn tails on the back.

## Step 8: Round 1 Base

Using **Light Pink B**, attach yarn behind the flower.

Chain **4** and join with a **sl st** to form a ring.

Round 1: Chain **3**, work **2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc** in the ring.

Repeat this corner group **3 more times**.

Join with a **sl st**.

You should have **4 corner spaces**.

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## Step 9: Round 2

Slip stitch to the next **corner ch-2 space**.

Chain **3**.

In the same corner space, work:

**2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc**

In the next corner space, work:

**3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc**

Repeat around.

Join with a sl st.

You should now have **8 clusters** and **4 corner ch-2 spaces**.

## Step 10: Round 3

Slip stitch to the next corner space.

Chain **3**.

Work **2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc** in the same corner.

In each side space, work **3 dc**.

In each corner, work **3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc**.

Continue around and join with a sl st.

This round begins forming the square shape clearly.

## Step 11: Round 4 Lacy Border

Slip stitch to any **ch-2 space**.

Chain **1**.

Work **sc in the same space**.

Chain **5**, then work **sc in the next ch-2 space**.

Repeat around the square.

This creates soft lace loops around the border.

Join and fasten off.

## Step 12: Fasten Off and Weave Ends

Use a yarn needle to weave in all loose ends on the back.

Trim extra yarn carefully.

Block the square gently so it becomes even and flat.

Do not press the 3D flower too much; keep the center raised.

## Finishing Tips

Use cotton yarn for better stitch definition.

Keep your stitches consistent so the square stays even.

Block the granny square lightly after finishing.

This **3D Flower Granny Square** can be used for blankets, pillows, bags, wall decor, table runners, or handmade gifts.

## Project Ideas

You can join several squares together to make a floral blanket.

Use one square as the front panel of a crochet bag.

Sew it onto a pillow cover for a handmade decorative touch.

Make several in different colors for wall art or spring home decor.

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
