



SUNGLASSES CHICKENS POCKET QUILT

— Step-by-Step Tutorial (All measurements in CM) —

A fun and functional wall quilt with 3 pocket chickens to hold your sewing tools. Beginner friendly with fusible appliqué and simple piecing.

FINISHED SIZE

Wall Quilt: 70 cm wide x 75 cm high

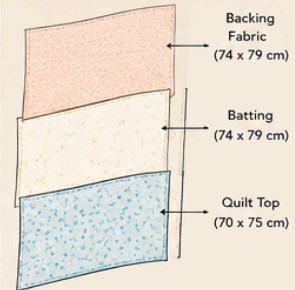
MATERIALS

- ♥ Assorted quilting cotton fabrics
- ♥ Fusible web (lite)
- ♥ Batting (80% cotton or cotton blend) 74 x 79 cm
- ♥ Backing fabric 74 x 79 cm
- ♥ Thread (matching & contrasting)
- ♥ Black felt or fabric for sunglasses
- ♥ Yellow felt or fabric for sunglasses frame
- ♥ Lightweight fusible interfacing (optional, for pockets)
- ♥ Basic sewing tools and sewing machine
- ♥ Rotary cutter, mat, ruler
- ♥ Iron and ironing board
- ♥ Fabric glue pen (optional)

COLOR SUGGESTION

- Background: Aqua/Turquoise
- Left Chicken: Yellow/Green
- Middle Chicken: Pink/Fuchsia
- Right Chicken: Magenta/Orange
- Pockets: Scrappy Prints
- Legs/Feet: Orange
- Sunglasses: Black & Yellow
- Border: Multi Prints

QUILT LAYERS (from bottom to top)

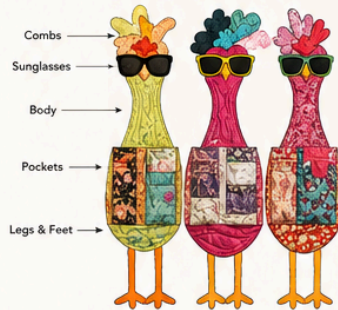


FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (All in CM)

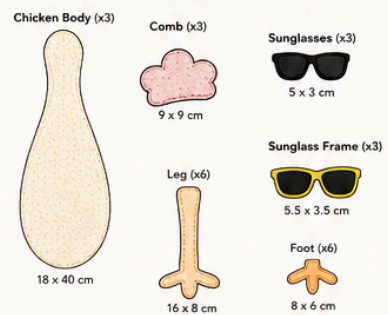
FABRIC	CUTTING SIZE	QTY
Background (Aqua)	52 x 57	1
Left Chicken Body (Yellow/Green)	18 x 40	1
Middle Chicken Body (Pink)	18 x 40	1
Right Chicken Body (Magenta)	18 x 40	1
Combs (Various)	9 x 9	3 sets
Sunglasses (Black)	5 x 3	3
Sunglass Frames (Yellow)	5.5 x 3.5	3
Pockets (Scrappy)	Various	3 sets
Legs & Feet (Orange)	16 x 12	3 sets
Border Strips (Multi Prints)	6 x 70 (Top & Bottom) 6 x 75 (Sides)	2
Binding (Multi Prints)	6 x 270	1
Backing	74 x 79	1
Batting	74 x 79	1

* Add 1 cm seam allowance to all pieces when cutting.

APPLIQUÉ PIECES GUIDE (Actual Size)



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

1 PREPARE & CUT FABRICS

Wash, dry and iron all fabrics. Cut all fabrics according to the Fabric Requirements table.



2 APPLIQUÉ CHICKEN BODIES

Fuse the body pieces (18 x 40 cm) onto the background using fusible web. Use a zigzag or blanket stitch around edges.



3 ADD COMBS

Fuse and stitch the comb pieces (9 x 9 cm) on top of each chicken's head.



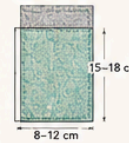
4 ADD SUNGLASSES

Fuse black sunglasses (5 x 3 cm) and yellow frames (5.5 x 3.5 cm) on each chicken. Stitch around edges.



5 MAKE POCKETS

Sew scrappy fabric pieces together (8-12 cm wide, 15-18 cm high). Press seams open. Fold top edge 1 cm to the wrong side, then fold again 2 cm and stitch to form the pocket opening. Topstitch sides and bottom. Make 3 pockets (one for each chicken).



6 ATTACH POCKETS

Position one pocket on each chicken body. Align the sides and top. Topstitch around sides and bottom of each pocket.



7 ADD LEGS & FEET

Fuse the legs (16 x 8 cm) and feet (8 x 6 cm) on the bottom of each body. Stitch around edges.



8 QUILT THE BACKGROUND

Quilt as desired: straight lines, meander or pebbles work great. Keep quilting lines 0.5-1 cm apart for texture.



9 ADD BORDER

Sew border strips to the top, bottom, and sides:
• Top & Bottom: 6 x 70 cm
• Sides: 6 x 75 cm
Press seams outward.



10 LAYER & BASTE

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste using pins or basting spray.



11 QUILT SANDWICH

Quilt around the chickens, pockets, and background. Do echo quilting around motifs for a pop-out effect.



12 BIND THE QUILT

Use 6 x 270 cm binding strip.
• Fold in half lengthwise, wrong sides together. Press.
• Sew binding to front, miter corners.
• Fold to back and hand stitch or machine stitch.



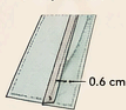
13 FINISH & ENJOY

Press your quilt. Add your sewing tools to the pockets and enjoy your fun, functional Sunglasses Chickens Pocket Quilt!



BASIC SEWING & QUILTING METHODS (US QUILT STYLE)

SEAM ALLOWANCE (Always 0.6 cm)



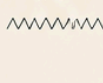
STRAIGHT STITCH

Use for piecing and topstitching.



ZIGZAG STITCH

Use for raw edge appliqué.



APPLIQUÉ

Fuse fabric with fusible web and stitch around edges.



TOPSTITCH

Sew along edge or seam for detail.



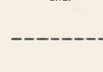
QUILTING

Stitch through all layers for texture and stability.



BACKSTITCH

Lock stitches at beginning and end.



MITERED CORNER

How to fold binding at corners.



TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Use high quality cotton fabrics.
- Press seams as you go.
- Take your time with appliqué.
- Quilting adds texture and personality! ♥

CARE INSTRUCTIONS



Machine wash cold, gentle.



Do not bleach.



Tumble dry low.



Warm iron if needed.



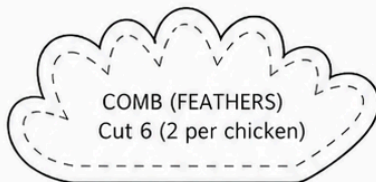
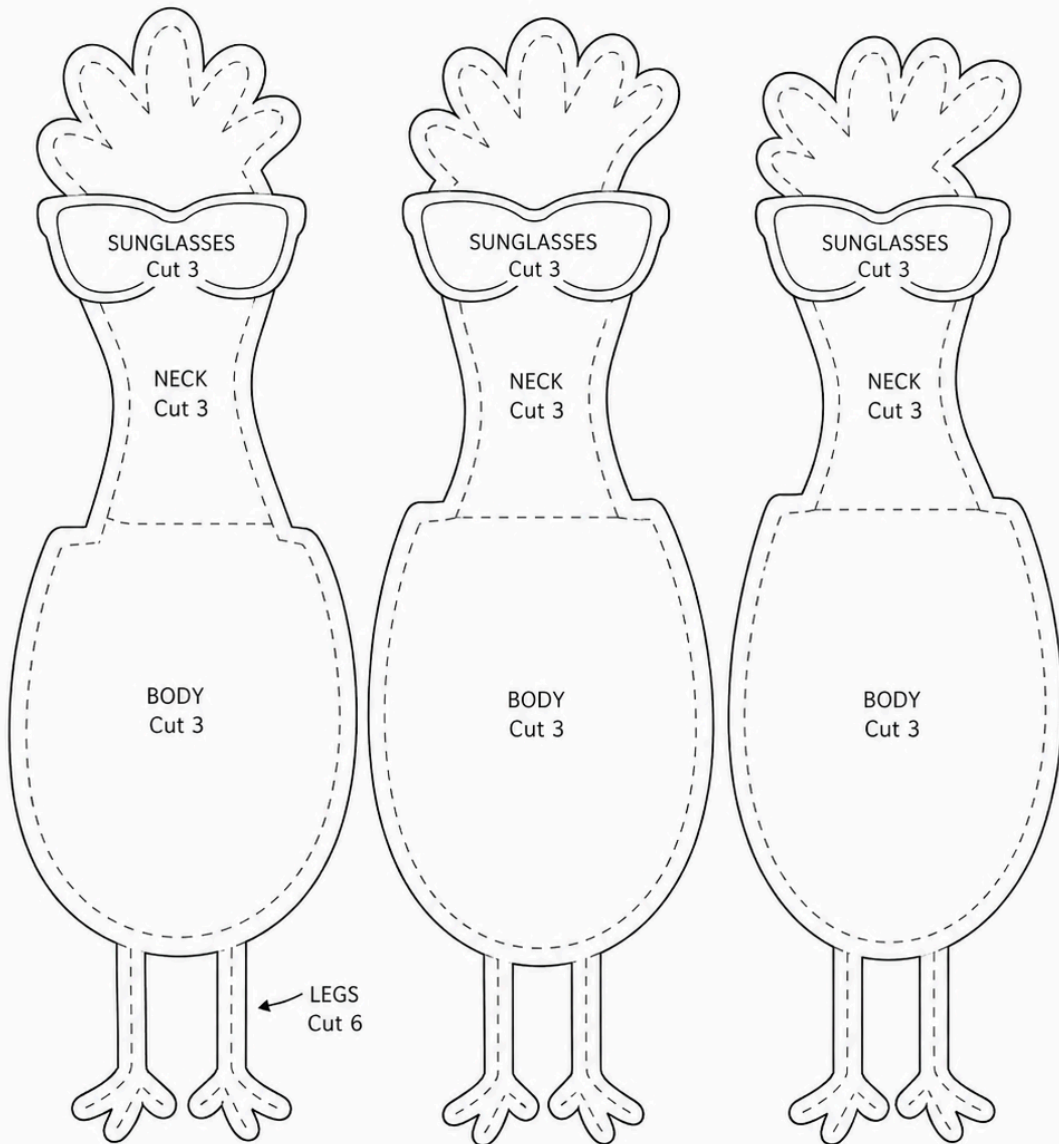
Do not dry clean.

Sunglasses Chickens Pocket Quilt Tutorial 🐔🕶️

Finished size: 70 cm wide x 75 cm high

Style: Wall quilt with 3 pocket chickens

Skill level: Beginner friendly

Seam allowance: 0.6 cm unless otherwise stated

Materials Needed

Assorted quilting cotton fabrics

Fusible web for appliqué

Batting: 74 x 79 cm

Backing fabric: 74 x 79 cm

Thread in matching and contrasting colors

Black felt or black fabric for sunglasses

Yellow felt or fabric for sunglasses frames

Lightweight fusible interfacing for pockets

Basic sewing tools

Rotary cutter, ruler, and cutting mat

Iron and ironing board

Fabric glue pen, optional

Fabric Cutting Guide

Background fabric: 52 x 57 cm, cut 1

Left chicken body, yellow/green: 18 x 40 cm, cut 1

Middle chicken body, pink/fuchsia: 18 x 40 cm, cut 1

Right chicken body, magenta/orange: 18 x 40 cm, cut 1

Combs: 9 x 9 cm, cut 3 sets

Black sunglasses: 5 x 3 cm, cut 3

Yellow sunglasses frames: 5.5 x 3.5 cm, cut 3

Scrappy pocket fabrics: assorted pieces, cut 3 sets

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Legs and feet, orange: 16 x 12 cm, cut 3 sets

Border strips: 6 x 70 cm for top and bottom, cut 2

Border strips: 6 x 75 cm for sides, cut 2

Binding: 6 x 270 cm total

Backing: 74 x 79 cm

Batting: 74 x 79 cm

Add 1 cm seam allowance to appliqué pieces when cutting, unless using exact-size templates.

Step 1: Prepare and Cut the Fabrics

Wash, dry, and iron all fabrics before starting.

Cut all fabric pieces according to the measurements listed above.

Use the tutorial image as your visual guide for the chicken shapes, combs, sunglasses, legs, feet, and pockets.

Fuse the appliqué pieces to fusible web following the manufacturer's instructions.

Step 2: Prepare the Background

Place the aqua background fabric flat on your work surface.

Mark the approximate position of the three chickens.

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Leave space at the top for the combs and sunglasses, and leave space at the bottom for the legs and feet.

The chickens should sit evenly across the background.

Step 3: Appliqué the Chicken Bodies

Place the three chicken body pieces onto the background.

The body pieces should measure about 18 x 40 cm each.

Fuse each body in place with an iron.

Stitch around the edges using zigzag stitch, blanket stitch, or a narrow appliqué stitch.

Step 4: Add the Combs

Place one comb on top of each chicken's head.

Each comb should measure about 9 x 9 cm.

Fuse the combs in place.

Stitch carefully around the edges.

Use bright, playful fabrics for a fun handmade look.

Step 5: Add the Sunglasses

Cut three black sunglasses pieces measuring about 5 x 3 cm.

Cut three yellow sunglasses frames measuring about 5.5 x 3.5 cm.

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Place the yellow frame over or around the black sunglasses shape.

Fuse the sunglasses onto each chicken's face.

Stitch around the edges to secure them.

Step 6: Make the Pockets

For each chicken, sew small scrappy fabric pieces together to create one pocket.

Each finished pocket should be about 8–12 cm wide and 15–18 cm high.

Press the seams open.

Fold the top edge 1 cm to the wrong side, press, then fold again 2 cm and stitch to form a clean pocket opening.

Topstitch the sides and bottom only.

Do not sew the top closed.

Step 7: Attach the Pockets

Place one pocket on the lower body of each chicken.

Align the sides and bottom neatly.

Topstitch around the sides and bottom of each pocket.

Reinforce the top corners with a backstitch.

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These pockets can hold sewing tools, scissors, crochet hooks, pens, or small notions.

Step 8: Add the Legs and Feet

Place two orange legs under each chicken body.

Add one foot shape at the bottom of each leg.

Fuse the pieces in place.

Stitch around all edges.

Make sure the legs are centered and balanced under each chicken.

Step 9: Quilt the Background

Add quilting lines around the chickens, pockets, and background.

Straight lines, gentle waves, meanders, or pebble quilting all work well.

Keep quilting lines about 0.5–1 cm apart for nice texture.

Quilt around the appliqué shapes to help them stand out.

Step 10: Add the Border

Sew the top and bottom border strips first.

Use 6 x 70 cm strips.

Press seams outward.

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Then sew the side border strips.

Use 6 x 75 cm strips.

Press again.

Step 11: Layer and Baste the Quilt

Place the backing fabric wrong side up.

Place the batting on top.

Place the quilt top right side up.

Smooth all layers carefully.

Baste with pins or basting spray.

Step 12: Quilt the Sandwich

Quilt through all three layers.

Stitch around the chickens, sunglasses, pockets, legs, and feet.

Add extra quilting to the background for texture.

Do not quilt the pocket openings closed.

Step 13: Bind the Quilt

Prepare a 6 x 270 cm binding strip.

Fold the binding in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press.

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Sew the binding to the front of the quilt.

Miter the corners neatly.

Fold the binding to the back.

Hand stitch or machine stitch it in place.

Step 14: Final Touches

Press the quilt carefully.

Trim any loose threads.

Check that all pocket openings are free and usable.

Add sewing tools or decorative items to the pockets.

Your Sunglasses Chickens Pocket Quilt is finished!



Care Instructions

Machine wash cold on gentle cycle.

Do not bleach.

Tumble dry low.

Warm iron if needed.

Do not dry clean.

Tips for Success

Use high-quality cotton fabrics.

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Press seams as you go.

Take your time with appliqué stitching.

Use contrasting thread for decorative detail.

Keep the pocket tops open.

Quilt around the motifs to make the chickens pop.
