



DENIM PATCHWORK CHAIR CUSHION

♥ STEP-BY-STEP TUTORIAL ♥

A cozy and charming cushion made with denim squares, lace trim and pearl accents. Perfect for your home or as a handmade gift! ♥

FINISHED SIZE

BACK CUSHION:
40 cm x 40 cm

SEAT CUSHION:
40 cm x 40 cm

(Thickness: ~3 cm)



FABRIC & MATERIALS (USA)

- Denim fabric (various shades) 1/2 yard
- Cotton fabric for back (lining) 1/2 yard
- Batting (quilt batting) 1/2 yard
- Lace trim (cotton) 3.5 cm wide, 3.2 m
- Pearl beads 25-30 pcs
- Coordinating thread
- Fabric marker / chalk
- Ruler, scissors, pins, sewing clips
- Sewing machine
- Iron
- Ribbon or fabric ties 4 ties, 40 cm each



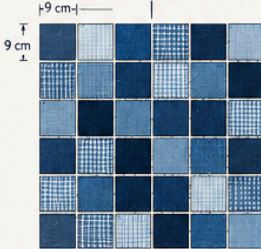
METHODS USED (SEWING BASICS)

- Seam allowance: 1 cm
- Straight stitching
- Topstitching
- Pressing
- Hand sewing (beads)
- Quilting (optional)
- Binding / Lace application
- Tie attachment

CUTTING GUIDE (ALL MEASUREMENTS IN CM) ♥

PATCHWORK SQUARES

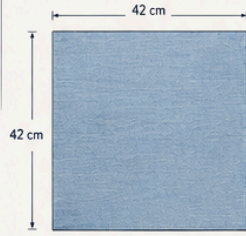
(Cut 49 squares 9 cm x 9 cm)



Arrange in 7 rows x 7 columns

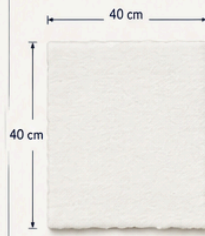
BACKING FABRIC (2 PIECES)

(for back cushion and seat)



BATTING (2 PIECES)

(for back cushion and seat)



ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM



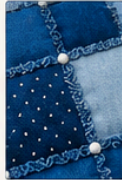
STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS ♥

1 PREPARE PATCHWORK TOP



- Arrange the 49 squares (7x7) in a pleasing mix of shades and prints.
- Sew the squares together into 7 rows.
- Press the seams.
- Sew the rows together to form a 40 cm x 40 cm patchwork panel.

2 ADD PEARL ACCENTS



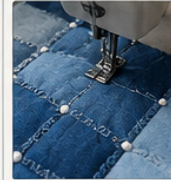
- Hand sew a pearl bead at each intersection of the squares.
- Secure tightly. (You will add pearls to 25-30 points.)

3 LAYER AND BASTE



- Place the patchwork panel right side up.
- Add batting (40x40 cm) on top.
- Add backing fabric (42x42 cm) on top, right side down.
- Baste or pin all layers together.

4 QUILT (OPTIONAL)



- Quilt along the seam lines of the patchwork (or around each square) to secure the layers.
- This adds durability and texture.

5 TRIM & ADD LACE



- Trim the layered piece to 40 cm x 40 cm (if needed).
- Place lace trim around the edge (right side).
- Sew the lace all around the cushion.

6 ATTACH TIES



- Cut 4 ties (40 cm each).
- Fold and sew each tie.
- Pin 2 ties to the top corners (back cushion) and 2 ties to the seat cushion.
- Sew securely.

7 REPEAT FOR BACK & SEAT



- Repeat the same steps to make the second cushion.
- You will have:
 - 1 Back Cushion (40x40 cm)
 - 1 Seat Cushion (40x40 cm)

8 FINISHED! ♥



- Your Denim Patchwork Chair Cushion is ready!
- Tie the cushions to your chair and enjoy the comfort and style.

SEWING TIPS ♥

- Use a denim needle (size 90/14 or 100/16).
- Press seams well for a flat finish.
- Use clips for thicker layers.
- Go slow when sewing over bulky seams.
- Hand sew pearls carefully for a secure and beautiful finish.



FABRIC GUIDE (USA)

- Denim: Medium weight (8-10 oz)
- Cotton lining: Quilting cotton
- Batting: Polyester or Cotton blend (for comfort and durability)



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Spot clean or hand wash gently.
- Air dry flat.
- Do not bleach.
- Iron on low heat if needed.
- Made to last with love! ♥

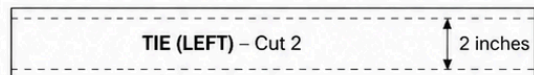
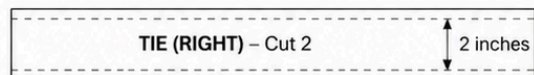
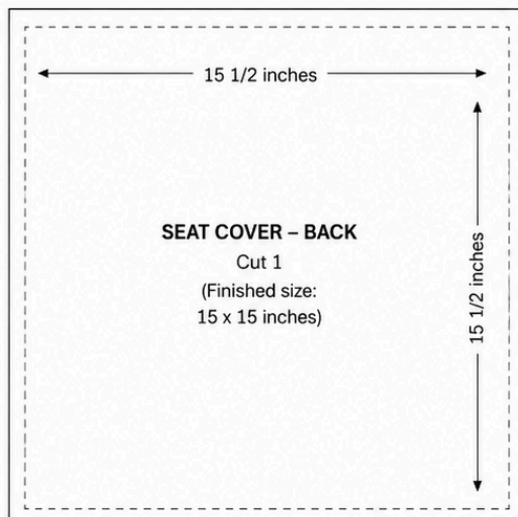
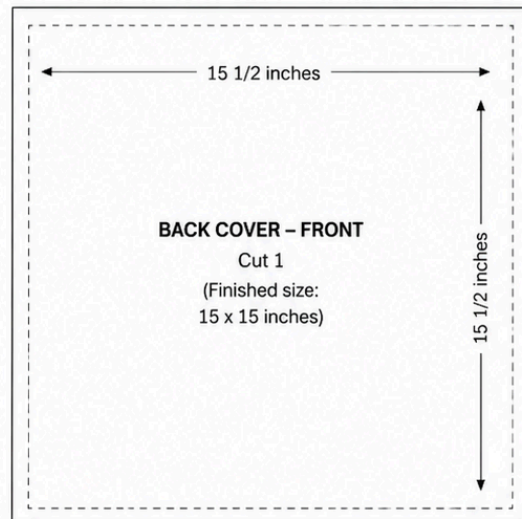
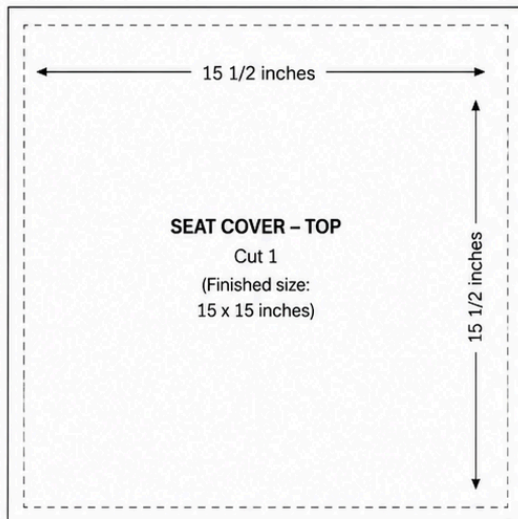

DENIM PATCHWORK CHAIR CUSHION COVER – PATTERN

Includes 1/4 inch (6 mm) seam allowance



20 inches



NOTES:

- All seam allowances are 1/4 inch (6 mm).
- Use a 1/4 inch foot while sewing.
- Attach ties to the back cover – front piece before assembling.
- Finish size may vary slightly depending on your sewing.

- - - - - 1/4 inch (6 mm) SEAM ALLOWANCE

* All pieces include 1/4 inch (6 mm) seam allowance.

Denim Patchwork Chair Cushion Step-by-Step Tutorial



Create a cozy Denim Patchwork Chair Cushion using denim squares, lace trim, pearl accents, and simple sewing techniques. This project includes one back cushion and one seat cushion, each measuring 40 cm x 40 cm with about 3 cm thickness.

Finished Size

Back cushion: 40 cm x 40 cm

Seat cushion: 40 cm x 40 cm

Approximate thickness: 3 cm

Materials Needed

Denim fabric in different shades: 1/2 yard

Cotton fabric for backing/lining: 1/2 yard

Quilt batting: 1/2 yard

Lace trim: 3.5 cm wide, about 3.2 m

Pearl beads: 25–30 pieces

Coordinating thread

Fabric marker or chalk

Ruler, scissors, pins, sewing clips

Sewing machine

Iron

Ribbon or fabric ties: 4 ties, 40 cm each

Cutting Guide

Cut 49 denim squares, each measuring 9 cm x 9 cm.

Cut the backing fabric into 2 pieces, each measuring 42 cm x 42 cm.

Cut the batting into 2 pieces, each measuring 40 cm x 40 cm.

The denim squares will be arranged in 7 rows x 7 columns to create one patchwork panel.

Step 1: Prepare the Patchwork Top

Arrange the 49 denim squares in a pleasing mix of light, medium, dark, and patterned denim.

Place them in 7 rows and 7 columns.

Sew the squares together row by row using a 1 cm seam allowance.

Press the seams carefully with an iron so the patchwork lays flat.

After all rows are joined, sew the rows together to form one 40 cm x 40 cm patchwork panel.

Step 2: Add Pearl Accents

Hand sew pearl beads at selected intersections between the denim squares.

You do not need to place pearls on every intersection.

Add about 25 to 30 pearl beads for a delicate decorative effect.

Make sure each pearl is sewn tightly so it stays secure during use.

Step 3: Layer and Baste

Place the patchwork panel right side up.

Add one 40 cm x 40 cm batting piece behind it.

Place the 42 cm x 42 cm backing fabric on the back, with the right side facing down.

Pin or baste all layers together so they do not shift while sewing.

Step 4: Quilt the Cushion

Quilting is optional, but it adds durability and texture.

Sew along the seam lines of the patchwork squares.

You may also quilt around each square if you want a more defined padded look.

Keep the stitches straight and slow for a neat finish.

Step 5: Trim and Add Lace

Trim the layered cushion piece to 40 cm x 40 cm, if needed.

Place the lace trim around the outer edge of the cushion.

The lace should sit along the right side edge, creating a soft decorative border.

Sew the lace all around the cushion, keeping the corners neat and even.

Step 6: Attach the Ties

Cut 4 ties, each measuring 40 cm.

Fold and sew each tie if you are making them from fabric, or use ribbon.

Attach 2 ties to the top corners of the back cushion.

Attach 2 ties to the back edge of the seat cushion.

Sew them securely so the cushions can be tied to the chair.

Step 7: Repeat for Back and Seat Cushion

Repeat the same process to make the second cushion.

You will have:

1 back cushion: 40 cm x 40 cm

1 seat cushion: 40 cm x 40 cm

Both cushions should have matching patchwork, lace trim, pearl details, and ties.

Step 8: Finish the Cushion

Check all seams and trim any loose threads.

Tie the cushions onto the chair.

Adjust the back and seat cushion so they sit comfortably.

Your Denim Patchwork Chair Cushion is ready to use and enjoy.

Sewing Tips

Use a denim needle, size 90/14 or 100/16.

Press seams well for a flat, clean finish.

Use sewing clips instead of pins when sewing thick layers.

Go slowly when sewing over bulky seams.

Hand sew pearls carefully for a secure and beautiful finish.

Fabric Guide

Use medium-weight denim, around 8–10 oz.

For the lining, quilting cotton works well.

For batting, use polyester or cotton blend for comfort and durability.

Care Instructions

Spot clean or hand wash gently.

Air dry flat.

Do not bleach.

Iron on low heat if needed.

Treat the cushion gently so the lace and pearls stay beautiful.

Final Result

You now have a handmade Denim Patchwork Chair Cushion with a cozy country-style look, soft padding, lace trim, and charming pearl accents. It is perfect for your home, porch, sewing room, or as a handmade gift.
