

# SCRIPT QUILT

## ★ MOON FAIRY & CAT ★

### COMPLETE STEP-BY-STEP TUTORIAL



FINISHED SIZE: 60 cm x 60 cm

#### 1. MATERIALS & CUTTING CHART

- 100% cotton fabric
- Cotton batting
- Cotton thread
- Fabric marking pen
- Quilting thread
- Sewing machine
- Rotary cutter & mat
- Iron & pressing board
- Pins / Clips
- Hand sewing needle
- Scissors

Navy  
(Background & Border)  
Cut: 1 square 70 cm x 70 cm

Moon (Cream)  
Cut: 1 piece

Fairy Hair (Teal)  
Cut: 1 piece

Fairy Skin (Light)  
Cut: Several pieces

Fairy Dress  
(Light Blue)  
Cut: Several pieces

Fairy Wings (Light Blue)  
Cut: 2 pieces

Cat (Orange)  
Cut: Several pieces

Blanket (Green)  
Cut: 1 piece  
22 cm x 30 cm

Stars (Gold)  
Cut: Several pieces

Backing Fabric  
Cut: 70 cm x 70 cm

Binding (Navy)  
Cut: 6 strips 6 cm x WOF

#### 2. APPLIQUÉ PIECES

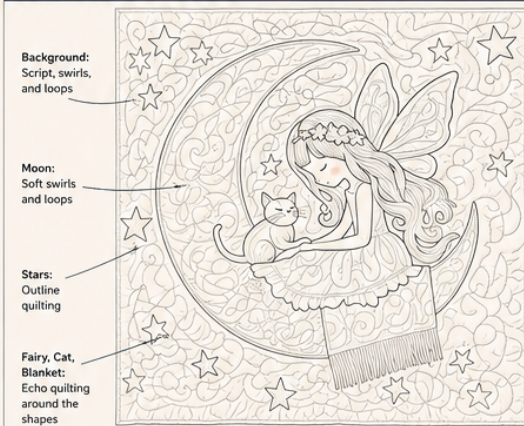


Add 0.7 cm seam allowance around all pieces.

#### 3. CONSTRUCTION STEPS

- 1 Prepare the Background**  
  
Cut the navy background square 70 x 70 cm. Press and mark the center.
- 2 Appliqué the Moon**  
  
Position and pin the moon on the left side. Fuse (optional) and appliqué with a straight stitch.
- 3 Appliqué the Blanket**  
  
Place the blanket over the lower tip of the moon. Appliqué and add fringe.
- 4 Appliqué the Fairy**  
  
Position the fairy on the blanket. Appliqué the body, dress, face and hair layer by layer.
- 5 Appliqué the Wings**  
  
Place the wings behind the fairy. Appliqué carefully.
- 6 Appliqué the Cat**  
  
Place the cat in front of the fairy. Appliqué all pieces.
- 7 Appliqué the Stars**  
  
Distribute the stars around the moon. Appliqué all stars.
- 8 Quilting (Script Style)**  
  
Quilt around all appliqué pieces. Use script and swirl designs in the background. Quilt the moon with a soft swirl pattern.
- 9 Layer the Quilt**  
  
Place backing fabric right side down. Add batting. Place quilt top right side up. Baste the layers.
- 10 Quilt**  
  
Quilt all layers together following the design. Use matching or invisible thread.
- 11 Trim & Square**  
  
Trim the edges to 60 cm x 60 cm square.
- 12 Bind the Quilt**  
  
Attach the binding strips. Fold to the back and hand stitch or machine stitch.

#### 4. QUILTING DESIGN GUIDE



#### 5. BINDING FINISH

- 1. Sew binding strips together.**
- 2. Attach binding to the front.**
- 3. Fold binding to the back.**
- 4. Hand stitch or machine stitch to finish.**

#### 6. MAIN SEWING & QUILTING METHODS (US QUILT STYLE)

| METHOD   | DESCRIPTION                                           | USED FOR                                  | TIP                                               |
|----------|-------------------------------------------------------|-------------------------------------------|---------------------------------------------------|
| Appliqué | Sewing fabric pieces onto a background.               | All characters, moon, stars, and blanket. | Use small stitches and appliqué foot if possible. |
| Pressing | Pressing seams and fabric for a crisp finish.         | All steps.                                | Press often for accurate piecing.                 |
| Basting  | Holding the quilt layers together.                    | Before quilting.                          | Use safety pins or basting spray.                 |
| Quilting | Stitching through all layers (top, batting, backing). | To add design and secure the layers.      | Follow the quilting design guide.                 |
| Binding  | Finishing the raw edges with fabric strips.           | To give a clean, durable edge.            | Miter the corners for a professional look.        |

#### 7. CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Hand wash or machine wash on gentle cycle.
- Use mild detergent.
- Do not bleach.
- Lay flat to dry.
- Iron on low heat if needed.

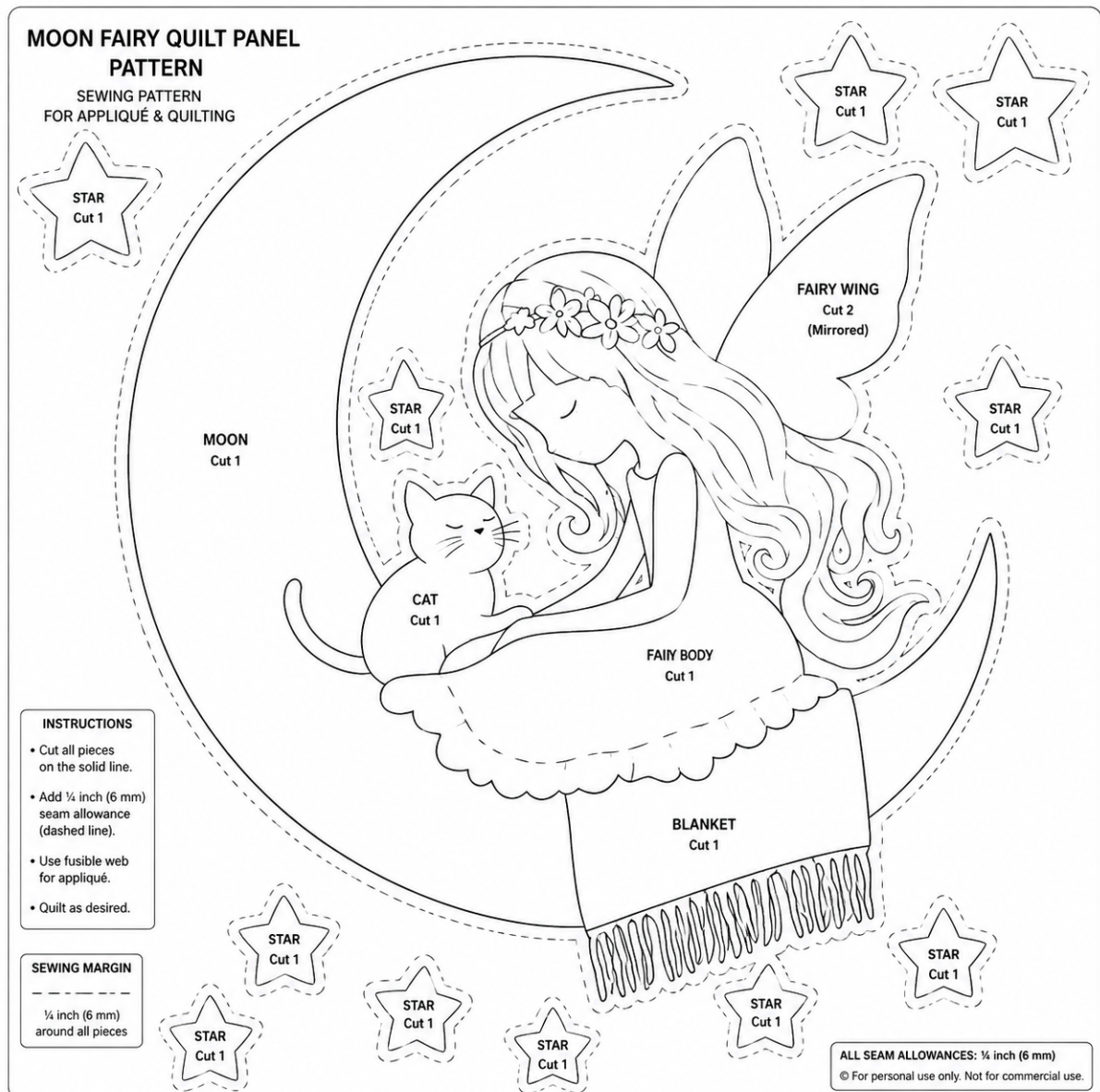
#### TIPS FOR SUCCESS

## **H2 – Materials and Supplies**

**Before starting, gather all the necessary supplies.**

**Fabrics**

- **100% Cotton Navy Fabric (background and border)**
- **Cream Cotton Fabric (moon)**
- **Light Blue Fabric (fairy dress)**
- **Light Blue Sheer or Cotton Fabric (wings)**
- **Teal Fabric (hair)**
- **Light Skin Tone Fabric**
- **Orange Fabric (cat)**
- **Olive Green Fabric (blanket)**
- **Gold Fabric (stars)**
- **Navy Fabric (binding)**
- **Navy Fabric (backing)**

#### **Batting**

- **Cotton Batting**
- **Finished size:**
  - **approximately 28" × 28" to allow trimming later**

#### **Thread**

**Use high-quality quilting thread.**

#### **Suggested colors:**

- **Navy**
- **Cream**
- **Light Blue**
- **Teal**
- **Gold**
- **Orange**
- **Olive Green**

#### **Tools**

- **Rotary cutter**
- **Self-healing cutting mat**

- Quilting ruler
- Fabric scissors
- Small embroidery scissors
- Fabric marking pen
- Iron
- Ironing board
- Sewing machine
- Walking foot
- Free-motion quilting foot (optional but recommended)
- Wonder Clips or quilting pins
- Temporary fabric glue (optional)

## **H2 – Cutting the Fabric**

**Cut all pieces before beginning assembly.**

### **Background**

- Navy square
- 27½" × 27½" (70 × 70 cm)

### **Moon**

#### **Cut:**

- 1 cream moon

### **Fairy Hair**

#### **Cut:**

- 1 teal hair piece

## **Fairy Face and Skin**

### **Cut:**

- **Face**
- **Neck**
- **Arms**
- **Hands**
- **Legs**
- **Feet**

**Cut several pieces according to the pattern.**

## **Fairy Dress**

### **Cut:**

- **Dress bodice**
- **Skirt**

**Light blue fabric**

## **Fairy Wings**

### **Cut:**

- **Left wing**
- **Right wing**

**Light blue fabric.**

## **Blanket**

### **Cut:**

- 1 rectangle

**Approximately:**

**22 × 30 cm**

**Add fringe after sewing.**

**Cat**

**Cut all cat pieces:**

- Body
- Tail
- Head
- Ears

**Orange fabric.**

**Stars**

**Cut several stars in different sizes.**

**Backing**

**Cut:**

- 27½" × 27½"

**Binding**

**Cut:**

**Six strips**

**2½" × Width of Fabric (WOF)**

## **H2 – Preparing the Appliqué Pieces**

**Transfer every pattern piece to the wrong side of the fusible web.**

**Cut roughly around each shape.**

**Fuse onto the wrong side of each fabric according to color.**

**Allow the pieces to cool.**

**Cut precisely on every outline.**

**Peel off the paper backing.**

**Your appliqué pieces are now ready.**

## **H2 – Preparing the Background**

**Press the navy background fabric carefully.**

**Locate the center.**

**Fold vertically.**

**Press lightly.**

**Fold horizontally.**

**Press lightly.**

**The fold marks create center guidelines.**

**These lines help position every element accurately.**

## **H2 – Positioning the Moon**

**Place the cream moon slightly left of center.**

**Leave enough room for:**

- **fairy**
- **blanket**
- **wings**
- **cat**

**Stand back and check the balance.**

**When satisfied:**

**Press with the iron.**

**Fuse the moon permanently.**

## **H2 – Appliqué the Moon**

**Use:**

- **blanket stitch**
- **satin stitch**
- **straight stitch**

**A narrow satin stitch gives excellent coverage.**

**Sew slowly around every curve.**

**Pivot often.**

**Do not stretch the fabric.**

## **H2 – Positioning the Blanket**

**Place the blanket over the lower section of the moon.**

**Allow part of the moon to remain visible.**

**Center the blanket beneath the fairy.**

**Fuse.**

**Stitch around the blanket.**

**Add the decorative fringe afterward.**

## **H2 – Building the Fairy**

**Now begin assembling the fairy.**

**Layer in this order:**

- 1. Legs**
- 2. Body**
- 3. Arms**
- 4. Face**
- 5. Neck**
- 6. Dress**
- 7. Hair**

**Check alignment before stitching.**

**Fuse each layer individually.**

**Sew every piece before adding the next.**

## **H2 – Sewing the Fairy Dress**

**Position the dress over the body.**

**Make sure the skirt drapes naturally over the blanket.**

**Fuse.**

**Sew around the dress.**

**If desired, add tiny decorative quilting lines to imitate fabric folds.**

## **H2 – Adding the Hair**

**Place the hair over the head and shoulders.**

**Allow long strands to flow downward naturally.**

**Fuse.**

**Sew around the outside edge.**

**For realism:**

**Add decorative stitching inside the hair following the curves.**

## **H2 – Adding the Wings**

**Position both wings behind the fairy.**

**Overlap slightly behind the shoulders.**

**Fuse.**

**Use matching light blue thread.**

**Stitch around each wing.**

**Optional:**

**Quilt extra feather-like veins inside the wings.**

## **H2 – Positioning the Cat**

**Place the cat sitting comfortably beside the fairy.**

**The cat should rest naturally on the moon.**

**Fuse.**

**Stitch around every edge.**

**Add embroidered whiskers afterward if desired.**

## **H2 – Positioning the Stars**

**Arrange stars throughout the background.**

**Avoid placing them too close together.**

**Mix different sizes.**

**Create a balanced composition.**

**Fuse every star.**

**Appliqué each one.**

## **H2 – Decorative Embroidery (Optional)**

**Enhance your quilt with embroidery.**

**Examples:**

- ★ **Hair highlights**
- ★ **Cat whiskers**
- ★ **Fairy flower crown**
- ★ **Blanket texture**
- ★ **Wing veins**
- ★ **Moon texture**

**Small embroidery details make the quilt much more expressive.**

## **H2 – Preparing the Quilt Sandwich**

**Layer the quilt in this order:**

**Bottom:**

**Backing**

**Middle:**

**Cotton batting**

**Top:**

**Appliqué quilt top**

**Smooth every layer carefully.**

**Remove wrinkles.**

**Pin every 3–4 inches.**

**Alternatively use spray basting.**

## **H2 – Quilting the Background**

**The original design uses flowing script quilting.**

**Fill the navy background with:**

- loops
- swirls
- cursive-style lines
- echo quilting

**Keep the quilting evenly distributed.**

**This creates beautiful texture while allowing the appliqué to stand out.**

## **H2 – Quilting the Moon**

**Use soft flowing curves.**

**Ideas include:**

- spirals
- feathers
- paisleys
- swirls

**Avoid dense quilting.**

**Let the moon remain soft and elegant.**

## **H2 – Quilting the Fairy**

**Quilt gently around the fairy.**

**Avoid heavy stitching over the face.**

**Instead:**

**Echo quilt around:**

- **hair**
- **arms**
- **dress**
- **wings**

**This helps every element stand out.**

## **H2 – Quilting the Blanket**

**Use parallel lines.**

**Crosshatching also looks beautiful.**

**The fringe can remain unquilted.**

## **H2 – Quilting the Cat**

**Use echo quilting around the body.**

**Avoid excessive stitching inside the cat.**

**Simple curved lines provide enough definition.**

## **H2 – Quilting the Stars**

**Outline quilt each star.**

**Then add small echo lines around them.**

**This makes every star sparkle visually.**

## **H2 – Trimming the Quilt**

**After quilting:**

**Lay the quilt flat.**

**Trim all sides.**

**Final size:**

**24" × 24"**

**Ensure every corner forms a perfect 90° angle.**

## **H2 – Making the Binding**

**Join the six binding strips.**

**Press seams open.**

**Fold the strip in half lengthwise.**

**Wrong sides together.**

**Press well.**

## **H2 – Attaching the Binding**

**Begin on one side.**

**Leave an 8-inch tail.**

**Sew with a ¼-inch seam allowance.**

**Miter every corner.**

**Continue around the quilt.**

**Join the beginning and ending tails neatly.**

## **H2 – Finishing the Binding**

**Fold the binding toward the back.**

**Clip in place.**

**Finish by:**

- **hand sewing with invisible stitches**

**or**

- **machine stitching close to the folded edge.**

**Take your time around the corners.**

**Well-finished corners give the quilt a professional appearance.**

## **H2 – Final Pressing**

**Lightly steam the finished quilt.**

**Avoid flattening the quilting texture.**

**Remove loose threads.**

**Inspect every seam.**

**The quilt is now complete.**

## **H2 – Care Instructions**

**To preserve your quilt:**

 **Wash using a gentle cycle.**

 **Use cold or lukewarm water.**

 **Mild detergent only.**

 **Do not bleach.**

 **Lay flat or hang to dry.**

 **Iron on low heat if necessary.**

**Store away from direct sunlight.**

## **H2 – Helpful Tips for Success**

**✓ Read the entire tutorial before cutting.**

**✓ Label every appliqué piece.**

**✓ Press after every sewing step.**

**✓ Use high-quality cotton fabric.**

- ✓ Test stitches on scrap fabric first.
- ✓ Replace sewing needles regularly.
- ✓ Keep seam allowances consistent.
- ✓ Work slowly around curves.
- ✓ Quilt from the center outward.
- ✓ Enjoy the creative process!
