

Boho Crochet Hat

Step-by-Step Tutorial

This boho-style crochet hat features colorful geometric patterns and is worked in continuous rounds. It's perfect for sunny days and adds a handmade touch to any outfit.

SIZE

Adult Medium
(Head circumference
22–23 in / 56–58 cm)



MATERIALS

- Worsted weight cotton yarn (Colors: Cream, Brick Red, Mustard, Navy Blue, Sage Green, Orange)
- 4.0 mm (G/6) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers (optional)



ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

ch	chain
sl st	slip stitch
sc	single crochet
dc	double crochet
hdc	half double crochet
inc	increase (2 sc in same stitch)
st(s)	stitch(es)

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

1 TOP (CROWN)



With Cream yarn.

Rnd 1: Magic ring, 8 sc in ring. (8)
Rnd 2: Inc in each st. (16)
Rnd 3: (Sc, inc) around. (24)
Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) around. (32)
Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) around. (40)
Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) around. (48)
Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) around. (56)
Rnd 8: (6 sc, inc) around. (64)
Rnd 9: Sc around. (64)

2 SIDE – CREAM SECTION



Continue in continuous rounds without joining.

Rnd 10–13: Sc around. (64)
(4 rounds of sc in Cream)

3 TRIANGLE PATTERN ROUND



Change colors as shown in chart. Work tapestry crochet (carry yarn on the inside).

Rnd 14: Follow Triangle Chart around. (64)

4 CREAM SECTION



With Cream yarn.

Rnd 15–17: Sc around. (64)
(3 rounds of sc in Cream)

5 DIAMOND PATTERN ROUND



Change colors as shown in chart. Work tapestry crochet.

Rnd 18: Follow Diamond Chart around. (64)

6 PREPARE FOR BRIM



With Cream yarn.

Rnd 19: Sc around. (64)
Rnd 20: Sc around in back loops only. (64)

This creates a clear fold line for the brim.

TRIANGLE PATTERN CHART (Rnd 14)



Repeat this 16-stitch sequence 4 times around (64 sts total). Colors in order: Mustard – Navy – Mustard – Sage Green.

■ Cream ■ Mustard ■ Navy Blue ■ Sage Green

DIAMOND PATTERN CHART (Rnd 18)



Repeat this 16-stitch sequence 4 times around (64 sts total). Colors in order: Sage Green – Cream – Orange – Brick Red.

■ Navy Blue ■ Sage Green ■ Cream ■ Orange ■ Brick Red

BRIM INSTRUCTIONS

Work increases to shape the brim and create the border pattern.

Rnd 21: (Sc in next 7 sts, inc) repeat around. (72)

Rnd 22: (Sc in next 8 sts, inc) repeat around. (80)

Rnd 23: (Sc in next 9 sts, inc) repeat around. (88)

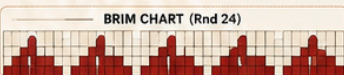
Rnd 24: Follow Brim Chart (red triangles).

Rnd 25: Sc around with Cream.

Rnd 26: Sc around with Navy.

Rnd 27: Sc around with Cream.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.



Repeat this 16-stitch sequence 5 times around (80 sts).

■ Cream ■ Brick Red

FINISHING



1. Shape the brim
Gently fold the brim along Rnd 20 (back loops) to help it hold its shape.



2. Check the shape
Make sure the brim is even all around and the hat fits comfortably.



3. Weave in ends
Use a yarn needle to hide all yarn tails on the inside of the hat.



4. Block (optional)
Lightly steam or block your hat to even out the stitches.



5. Enjoy your hat!
Your boho crochet hat is ready to wear!

TIPS

- Carry yarn loosely when working tapestry crochet.
- Keep your tension even for a smooth fabric.
- Use stitch markers to keep track of rounds.
- Block the hat for a professional finish.



BASIC STITCHES (US TERMS)

CHAIN (ch)



Yarn over, pull through loop on hook.

SLIP STITCH (sl st)



Insert hook, yarn over, pull through both loops on hook.

SINGLE CROCHET (sc)



Insert hook, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through both loops.

HALF DOUBLE CROCHET (hdc)



Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops.

DOUBLE CROCHET (dc)



Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through last 2 loops.

INCREASE (inc)



Work 2 single crochets in the same stitch.

COLORFUL CROCHET HAT

CROCHET CHART AND INSTRUCTIONS



MATERIALS

- Worsted weight yarn in the following colors: Cream (A), Red (B), Navy Blue (C), Mustard (D), Sage Green (E), Orange (F)
- 4.0 mm (G) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle, scissors

GAUGE

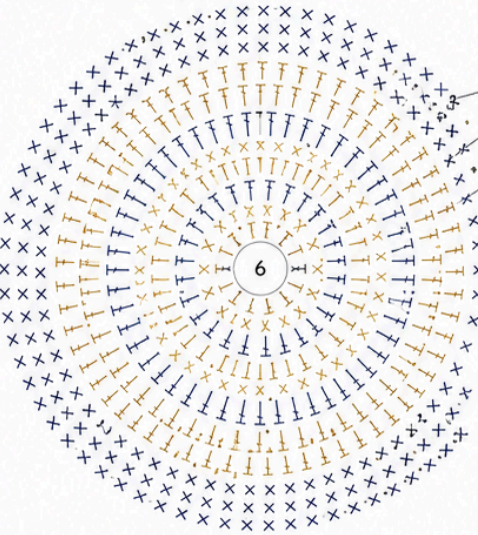
16 sc x 16 rows = 4" (10 cm) in single crochet

STITCH KEY (US TERMS)

- Chain (ch)
- Slip stitch (sl st)
- × Single crochet (sc)
- ┐ Half double crochet (hdc)
- ┘ Double crochet (dc)
- ⦶ 3 dc together (cluster)
- Λ 2 dc together (dec)
- ∨ V-stitch (dc, ch 1, dc in same st)

Colors: A = Cream, B = Red, C = Navy Blue, D = Mustard, E = Sage Green, F = Orange

CROWN (Worked in rounds)



- Round 1: With A, 6 sc in magic ring (6)
- Round 2: 2 sc in each st (12)
- Round 3: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) repeat around (18)
- Round 4: (2 sc, 2 sc in next st) repeat around (24)
- Round 5: (3 sc, 2 sc in next st) repeat around (30)
- Round 6: (4 sc, 2 sc in next st) repeat around (36)
- Round 7: (5 sc, 2 sc in next st) repeat around (42)
- Round 8: (6 sc, 2 sc in next st) repeat around (48)
- Rounds 9–13: Sc in each st around (48)

TOP EDGE PATTERN (Around crown)



- Rnd 1: With A, sc in each st around
- Rnd 2: With B, (sc in next 2 sts, skip 1 st) repeat around
- Rnd 3: With A, sl st in each st around

TRIANGLE BAND (Around crown)



- Rnd 1: With A, sc in each st around
- Rnd 2: Work triangles as follows: (5 dc in next st, skip 2 sts) repeat around
 - First repeat: With C (navy)
 - Second repeat: With D (mustard)
 - Third repeat: With E (sage green)
 - Continue repeating colors in this order
- Rnd 3: With A, sc in each st around
- Rnd 4: With A, sl st in each st around

GEOMETRIC BAND (Around crown)

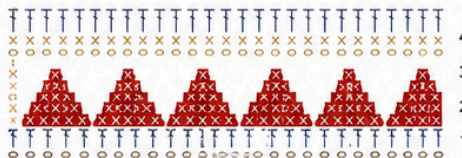


- Rnd 1: With A, sc in each st around
- Rnd 2–5: Follow the color chart above using single crochet (sc) Work the pattern in sequence and repeat around

COLOR CHART FOR BANDS

- A Cream
- B Red
- C Navy Blue
- D Mustard
- E Sage Green
- F Orange

BRIM (Worked in rounds)



- Rnd 1: With A, sc in each st around
- Rnd 2: With B, (dc in next st, skip 1 st) repeat around (zigzag)
- Rnd 3: With C, sc in each st around
- Rnd 4: With A, sc in each st around to finish

FINISHING

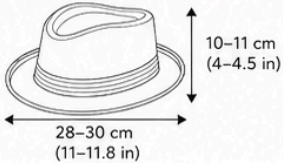
Weave in all ends.
Block the hat for a neat shape.

SIZE

Adult size
Head circumference:
Approx. 56–58 cm (22–23 in)

CROCHET HOOK GUIDE

Hook Size	Use For
3.5 mm (E)	Tighter stitch, firm fabric
4.0 mm (G)	Recommended for this pattern
4.5 mm (H)	Looser stitch, softer fabric



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Boho Crochet Hat – Step-by-Step Tutorial

Create a beautiful **Boho Crochet Hat** featuring geometric tapestry crochet inspired by Southwestern motifs. This original tutorial is designed using **US crochet terminology** and explains every stage in detail so that beginners with basic crochet knowledge and experienced crocheters alike can confidently complete the project.

The hat is worked from the **top down**, beginning with the crown, followed by the sides, decorative colorwork bands, and finally the wide brim.

The geometric motifs are worked using **tapestry crochet**, where unused yarn is carried inside the stitches to create neat color transitions. Take your time with each color change, maintain even tension, and enjoy watching the design come to life.

Materials

- Worsted Weight (#4) Cotton Yarn
 - Cream (Main Color)
 - Mustard
 - Navy Blue
 - Sage Green
 - Brick Red
 - Orange
- 4.0 mm (G/6) Crochet Hook
- Yarn Needle
- Stitch Markers
- Measuring Tape
- Scissors

Finished Size

Adult Medium

Head Circumference:
22–23 inches (56–58 cm)

The size can easily be adjusted by changing the number of increase rounds in the crown.

Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch – chain
- sl st – slip stitch
- sc – single crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- dc – double crochet
- inc – work 2 sc in the same stitch
- st – stitch
- sts – stitches
- rnd – round
- rep – repeat
- FO – fasten off

Before You Begin ✨

This hat is crocheted in **continuous spiral rounds**. Do not join unless instructed.

Place a stitch marker in the first stitch of every round.

When working the decorative sections, carry the unused yarn loosely inside the stitches to produce clean color changes without tightening the fabric.

Take a few moments to organize your yarn before beginning. Since several colors are introduced throughout the project, keeping each skein untangled will make the process much smoother.

Step 1 – Crochet the Crown 🧶

The crown forms the top of the hat.

Start with the Cream yarn.

Create a magic ring.

Work 8 single crochet into the ring.

Pull the ring closed firmly.

Continue increasing evenly every round until the crown reaches the desired diameter.

A flat crown is important.

If your work begins to curl upward too early, add another increase round.

If it begins to ripple, reduce the number of increases.

Continue crocheting until the crown measures approximately:

- 6½–7 inches (16.5–18 cm)

The crown should lay perfectly flat on a table.

Step 2 – Build the Hat Sides

Once the crown reaches the correct diameter, stop increasing.

Continue working one single crochet in every stitch.

This causes the fabric to naturally begin curving downward.

Do not force the curve.

Allow it to happen naturally as each round is completed.

Continue until the sides measure approximately:

4–4½ inches (10–11 cm)

Keep your stitch count constant throughout this section.

Check occasionally that the hat comfortably fits around the head.

Step 3 – Begin the First Decorative Band

Now the fun begins.

Introduce the first geometric pattern using tapestry crochet.

Keep Cream as the background color.

Add Mustard.

Add Navy Blue.

Add Sage Green.

Carry the unused yarn inside the stitches rather than floating it behind the work.

This keeps the inside of the hat neat and helps maintain the fabric's structure.

When changing colors:

Insert hook.

Yarn over with the current color.

Pull up a loop.

Before completing the stitch, switch to the new color.

Complete the stitch using the new yarn.

This produces clean transitions.

Maintain relaxed tension.

Never pull the carried yarn tightly.

Step 4 – Continue the Body

After finishing the first decorative section, return to working with Cream only.

Crochet several rounds evenly.

No increases are made.

No decreases are made.

This creates visual spacing between the decorative bands and allows the motifs to stand out beautifully.

Keep checking the fit while crocheting.

The hat should comfortably reach just above the ears.

Step 5 – Work the Diamond Pattern ♦

Introduce the second tapestry crochet band.

Use:

- Navy Blue
- Sage Green
- Cream
- Orange
- Brick Red

The diamond motifs are worked one stitch at a time.

Pay close attention to each color transition.

Remember that every stitch builds one "pixel" of the design.

Work slowly.

Count often.

Correct small mistakes immediately before they become difficult to fix.

The decorative band should wrap evenly around the hat without distortion.

Step 6 – Prepare for the Brim

Return to Cream yarn.

Continue crocheting one single crochet in every stitch.

This section separates the decorative band from the brim.

Work evenly while maintaining identical stitch count.

The hat should now resemble a finished fedora without the brim extension.

Check that the sides remain straight.

Steam lightly if necessary before continuing.

Step 7 – Shape the Brim 🌞

The brim is created by increasing gradually over several rounds.

Instead of increasing all at once, distribute increases evenly.

This creates a smooth outward flare.

A gradual increase produces the classic boho silhouette.

After every increase round, crochet one plain round without increases.

This helps stabilize the brim.

As the brim widens, lay the hat on a flat surface regularly.

The brim should remain flat without waves.

If slight ripples appear, reduce the increase frequency.

If the brim curls upward, add another increase round.

Continue until the brim reaches approximately:

2½–3 inches (6–7.5 cm)

Step 8 – Create the Decorative Brim Edge ❤️

Finish the brim with another geometric tapestry section.

Use Cream together with Brick Red.

Work slowly around the edge.

Since this is the widest portion of the hat, maintaining even stitch spacing is especially important.

The border frames the entire design beautifully.

Finish with one final round in Cream.

Step 9 – Fasten Off and Weave in Ends

Cut the yarn leaving a 6-inch tail.

Pull the yarn completely through the last loop.

Thread the tail onto a yarn needle.

Weave all yarn tails through the inside of the stitches.

Hide every color separately.

Avoid trimming the yarn too closely.

Well-hidden tails improve durability.

Step 10 – Block the Hat

Blocking gives the hat its final professional appearance.

Lightly spray the hat with water.

Place it over:

- a bowl
- a hat form
- or a mannequin head

Shape the crown.

Smooth the brim.

Allow it to dry completely.

Do not rush this step.

Blocking greatly improves stitch definition.

Step 11 – Final Inspection

Examine every decorative band.

Check for loose yarn tails.

Confirm that the brim lies evenly.

Verify that the fit is comfortable.

The finished hat should feel firm yet flexible, with crisp geometric colorwork and a smooth, well-shaped brim ready to wear.

Helpful Tips

- Always carry yarn loosely inside the stitches.
- Count stitches after every round.
- Use stitch markers generously.
- Keep consistent tension throughout the project.
- Practice color changes before beginning the decorative sections.
- Steam blocking can enhance stitch definition.
- Cotton yarn provides excellent structure and crisp colorwork.
- Avoid pulling carried yarn too tightly.
- Roll the yarn into small bobbins if colors become tangled.
- Enjoy the process—slow, steady stitching produces the best results.

Basic Stitch Guide

Chain (ch)

Yarn over and pull through the loop on your hook.

Slip Stitch (sl st)

Insert hook, yarn over, and pull through both the stitch and the loop on the hook.

Single Crochet (sc)

Insert hook into the stitch.

Yarn over.

Pull up a loop.

Yarn over again.

Pull through both loops.

Half Double Crochet (hdc)

Yarn over.

Insert hook.

Pull up a loop.

Yarn over.

Pull through all three loops.

Double Crochet (dc)

Yarn over.

Insert hook.

Pull up a loop.

Yarn over.

Pull through two loops.

Yarn over.

Pull through remaining two loops.

Increase (inc)

Work two single crochet stitches into the same stitch.

Finishing Touches

Your completed **Boho Crochet Hat** is now ready to wear. Pair it with casual outfits, summer dresses, denim jackets, or festival attire for a relaxed bohemian look. With careful attention to stitch tension, clean color changes, and proper blocking, you'll have a beautifully structured handmade hat that showcases your crochet skills and timeless geometric style.

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
