

CROCHET PUPPY WALL ORGANIZER

Step-by-Step Tutorial with Complete Instructions



MATERIALS

- Medium Weight (4) Cotton Yarn
 - Mustard Yellow
 - Teal
 - Light Blue
 - Navy Blue
 - Beige (Light)
 - Gray
 - Pink/Blush
 - Black (for nose)
- 3.5 mm (E) Crochet Hook
- 10 mm Safety Eyes (2)
- Yarn Needle
- Scissors
- Stuffing (for pockets if desired)
- Wooden Dowel (25–30 cm / 10–12 in)
- Cotton Cord or Rope (for hanger)

FINISHED SIZE

Approximately
38 cm (15 in) wide
by 55 cm (21.5 in) tall
(excluding hanger)



PART 1: PUPPY FACE

- 1. MUZZLE (beige)**
Start with magic ring.
R1: 6 sc in ring (6)
R2: 2 sc in each st (12)
R3: (sc, inc) x 6 (18)
R4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)
R5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)
R6: (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)
R7: (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)
R8: (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)
Fasten off.



- 2. FACE (top part)**
Make 3 panels and join.
Left (gray):
R1–R8: Work same increases as muzzle.
Fasten off.
Center (beige):
R1–R8: Work same increases.
Fasten off.
Right (pink):
R1–R8: Work same increases.
Fasten off.
Join panels together with slip stitches along the edges.



- 3. EARS (make 2, mustard)**
Ch 9.
R1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and across (8)
R2: inc, 6 sc, inc (10)
R3: inc, 8 sc, inc (12)
R4–R18: sc across (12)
Fold in half and sc around edges.
Fasten off.
- 4. NOSE (black)**
Magic ring.
R1: 6 sc in ring (6)
R2: 2 sc in each st (12)
R3: (sc, inc) x 6 (18)
Fasten off, leave long tail.



PART 2: BODY (PATCHWORK)

Make 24 squares. Each square is worked in continuous rounds.

- SQUARE (make 24 total in 6 colors)**
Magic ring.
R1: 8 sc in ring (8)
R2: inc in each st around (16)
R3: (sc, inc) x 8 (24)
R4–R10: sc in each st around (24)
Fasten off.



ARRANGEMENT (6 squares wide x 6 rows tall)
See color layout below. Join squares using whip stitch or slip stitch as you go.



BODY SHAPING

After joining all squares, work a round of single crochet around the entire edge.
Work 3 sc in each corner stitch to gently round the shape.
Fasten off.



PART 3: POCKETS (make 6)

Make 6 pockets in 3 colors (2 of each color).

- Ch 18.
R1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and across (17)
R2–R16: ch 1, turn, sc across (17)
Fasten off.
Fold in half and sew sides and bottom to form pocket.



PART 4: ASSEMBLY

1. Sew the puppy face to the top of the body.
2. Sew the ears on each side.
3. Embroider mouth with black yarn.
4. Sew or embroider the nose in the center.
5. Attach the 6 pockets to the front as shown.
6. Weave in all ends.



PART 5: HANGER

1. Cut 2 pieces of rope (35–40 cm / 14–16 in).
2. Tie securely to each end of the wooden dowel.
3. Hang your organizer!



BASIC CROCHET STITCHES (US TERMS)

Chain (ch)
Yarn over, pull through loop.



Slip Stitch (sl st)
Insert hook, yarn over, pull through both loops.



Single Crochet (sc)
Insert hook, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through both loops.



Increase (inc)
Work 2 sc in the same stitch.



Magic Ring
Create an adjustable loop for working in the round.



TIPS & NOTES

- Use a stitch marker to mark the first stitch in every round.
- Keep your tension even for neat squares.
- You can add thin foam or cardboard inside pockets for more structure.
- This project is perfect for organizing craft supplies, toys, or school items!



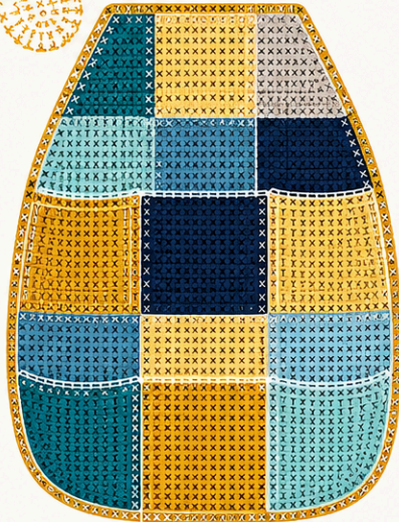

1. DOG HEAD (Make 2)



2. BODY (Make 1)



STITCH LEGEND (US TERMS)

- o ch - chain
- sl st - slip stitch
- x sc - single crochet
- T hdc - half double crochet
- F dc - double crochet
- F tr - treble crochet
- Ø magic ring
- () repeat instructions
- () total stitches in round

MATERIALS

- Worsted weight cotton yarn in the following colors: Mustard, Beige, Light Beige, Gray, Blush Pink, Teal, Light Blue, Navy Blue
- 3.5 mm (E/4) crochet hook
- Safety eyes (9 mm)
- Black yarn for embroidery
- Wooden dowel (30 cm / 12")
- Cotton cord or yarn for hanging
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

SIZE (approx.)

Height: 45 cm / 17.7 in
Width: 28 cm / 11 in

ABBREVIATIONS

- ch chain
- sl st slip stitch
- sc single crochet
- hdc half double crochet
- dc double crochet
- tr treble crochet
- st(s) stitch(es)
- MR magic ring

3. POCKETS (Make as indicated)

SIDE POCKETS (Make 2 each)



CENTER POCKET (Make 1)



UPPER POCKETS (Make 2)



4. OTHER PIECES

NOSE (Make 1)



TAIL TIP (Make 1)



HANGING LOOPS (Make 2)

- ch 30
- Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across (29 sc)

ASSEMBLY

1. Crochet all pieces following the charts.
2. Embroider the mouth with black yarn.
3. Sew the head pieces together around the edge (sc), stuff lightly before closing completely.
4. Attach the ears to the head.
5. Sew the head to the top of the body.
6. Arrange and sew all pockets onto the body as shown in the photo.
7. Make and attach the hanging loops to the back top.
8. Slide the wooden dowel through the loops and hang on the wall.



RECOMMENDED HOOK SIZE

3.5 mm (E/4)
Adjust hook size if needed to obtain a tight fabric.



TIPS

- Use a stitch marker in the first stitch of each round.
- Work in continuous rounds unless otherwise stated.
- Weave in all ends neatly.

Crochet Puppy Wall Organizer – Complete Step-by-Step Tutorial

Create an adorable Crochet Puppy Wall Organizer that is both decorative and practical. This original crochet project combines colorful patchwork, a friendly puppy face, and useful

storage pockets, making it perfect for organizing craft supplies, children's accessories, mail, or small household items.

This tutorial uses US crochet terminology and is written for adventurous beginners and intermediate crocheters. Every step is explained in detail so you can confidently complete the project from start to finish.

Materials

Before you begin, gather all your supplies.

Yarn

Use a medium-weight (#4 Worsted Weight) cotton yarn for durability.

Suggested colors:

- Cream
- Light Beige
- Gray
- Soft Pink or Light Brown
- Mustard Yellow
- Teal
- Navy Blue
- Light Blue
- Black

Feel free to customize the colors to create your own unique puppy.

Crochet Hook

Use a 3.5 mm (E) crochet hook.

If your stitches are naturally loose, consider using a slightly smaller hook.

Additional Supplies

- **Yarn needle**
- **Stitch markers**
- **Sharp scissors**
- **Fiberfill (optional for extra dimension)**
- **Two 10 mm safety eyes (or embroider the eyes)**
- **Wooden dowel (approximately 10–12 inches / 25–30 cm)**
- **Cotton rope or cord**
- **Measuring tape**
- **Sewing pins**

Finished Size

The finished organizer can be adjusted to your preference.

A comfortable finished size is approximately:

- **Width: 15 inches (38 cm)**
- **Height: 22 inches (56 cm), excluding the hanger**

Your size may vary depending on yarn, hook, and tension.

Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)

- **ch = chain**
- **sl st = slip stitch**
- **sc = single crochet**
- **hdc = half double crochet**
- **dc = double crochet**
- **inc = increase**
- **dec = decrease**
- **st = stitch**
- **sp = space**
- **MR = magic ring**
- **FO = fasten off**

Step 1 – Understanding the Project

This organizer is made from several individual pieces:

- **One puppy face**
- **Two floppy ears**
- **One nose**
- **One body**
- **Several colorful squares**
- **Six storage pockets**
- **One hanging system**

Working on each piece separately makes the project easier and more enjoyable.

Take your time and complete one section before moving on.

Step 2 – Crochet the Puppy Muzzle

Begin with a Magic Ring.

Work single crochet stitches evenly around the ring.

Increase gradually over several rounds until the circle becomes smooth and perfectly flat.

Avoid increasing too quickly.

If your circle starts to ruffle, reduce the number of increases.

If it curls upward, add a few more increases evenly around the next round.

Continue until the muzzle reaches the desired size.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing later.

Step 3 – Crochet the Puppy Face

The puppy's head is made from several curved sections worked separately.

Create one center section in cream.

Create one side section in gray.

Create the opposite side section in soft pink or light brown.

Each section should be slightly rounded to create the gentle shape of the puppy's face.

After completing all sections, place them side by side.

Use the yarn needle to sew them together with neat mattress stitches.

Once joined, lightly block the face if necessary.

Step 4 – Add the Eyes

Position the eyes before attaching the muzzle.

Place them evenly on each side of the face.

Check the symmetry several times before securing them.

If making this organizer for children under three years old, embroider the eyes instead of using safety eyes.

Secure all ends carefully.

Step 5 – Crochet the Puppy Ears

Create two matching ears.

Work each ear in rows.

Increase gradually to create a rounded shape.

Once the desired size is reached, continue working straight rows.

Round the tip gently by decreasing toward the end.

Fold each ear slightly before sewing.

This creates a realistic floppy appearance.

Step 6 – Crochet the Nose

Use black yarn.

Begin with a Magic Ring.

Create a small oval or rounded triangle using single crochet stitches.

Leave a long tail.

Later, embroider a simple smile beneath the nose using black yarn.

Small curved stitches create a cheerful expression.

Step 7 – Assemble the Puppy Face

Place the muzzle in the center.

Sew securely.

Attach the nose.

Embroider the mouth.

Attach both ears slightly behind the face.

Adjust the angle until the puppy has a friendly appearance.

Weave in every yarn end.

The face should now be complete.

Step 8 – Crochet the Colorful Patchwork Squares

The body is made from multiple colorful squares.

Choose six coordinating colors.

Work each square from the center outward.

Keep your stitch count consistent so every square measures exactly the same size.

Block the finished squares before assembly.

Uniform squares make the final organizer look much more professional.

Arrange the colors until you're happy with the layout.

Take a photo before joining if it helps you remember the design.

Step 9 – Join the Squares

Lay the squares flat.

Double-check the arrangement.

Join them using one of the following methods:

- **Slip Stitch Join**
- **Whip Stitch**
- **Mattress Stitch**
- **Join-as-you-go**

Keep the seams neat.

Avoid pulling the stitches too tightly.

Once joined, your patchwork panel should lay perfectly flat.

Step 10 – Shape the Body

The organizer has gently rounded lower corners.

After joining the squares, crochet a border around the entire body.

Work evenly around every edge.

At the bottom corners, use extra stitches to create smooth curves.

Continue until the outline looks balanced.

Add additional border rounds if you'd like a thicker edge.

Step 11 – Crochet the Storage Pockets

Create six rectangular pockets.

Each pocket should be large enough to hold small items such as:

- **Crochet hooks**
- **Pens**
- **Markers**
- **Small notebooks**
- **Scissors**
- **Brushes**

Work the rectangles using rows of single crochet.

Fold the bottom edge upward.

Sew both side edges.

Leave the top completely open.

Repeat for all six pockets.

Step 12 – Attach the Pockets

Arrange the pockets across the lower body.

Pin them first.

Check spacing carefully.

Sew around the sides and bottom only.

Reinforce the corners with several extra stitches.

This prevents the pockets from stretching over time.

Step 13 – Attach the Puppy Head

Position the completed puppy face at the top center.

Pin securely.

Sew around the entire edge.

Use small invisible stitches.

If desired, place a small amount of stuffing behind the head before closing.

This creates a soft three-dimensional effect.

Step 14 – Add Decorative Details

Now personalize your organizer.

Ideas include:

 **Embroidered paw prints**

 **Tiny crochet bone**

 **Small flowers**

 **Bow tie**

 Heart applique

 Stars

Keep decorations securely attached.

Step 15 – Create the Hanging System

Insert a wooden dowel through loops crocheted along the top edge.

Alternatively, sew small fabric loops onto the back.

Tie cotton rope securely to each end of the dowel.

Adjust the rope until the organizer hangs evenly.

Test it on a wall before filling the pockets.

Step 16 – Final Inspection

Carefully inspect every seam.

Check that:

- All yarn ends are woven in
- Pockets are secure
- Ears are symmetrical
- Face is centered
- Hanging cord is balanced

Make any final adjustments before use.

Tips for Success

 Maintain even tension throughout the project.

 Count stitches often.

 Block each piece before assembly.

 Sew pieces slowly for the best appearance.

 Use cotton yarn for durability.

 Reinforce pocket corners.

 Test the hanger before adding weight.

Care Instructions

Hand wash in cool water using mild detergent.

Do not bleach.

Lay flat to dry.

Avoid hanging while wet.

Store in a dry location away from direct sunlight to preserve the colors.

Troubleshooting

My squares are different sizes.

Check your tension and count stitches at the end of every round.

My organizer curls.

Blocking usually solves this problem.

My pockets stretch.

Use cotton yarn and reinforce the corners with extra stitches.

My puppy face looks uneven.

Pin every piece before sewing permanently.

Small adjustments make a big difference.

My organizer leans when hanging.

Shorten one side of the hanging cord until it becomes level.
