

# Crochet Flower Cross Car Hanger

Step-by-step tutorial



## 1. MATERIALS

- Worsted weight (4) cotton yarn
  - Pink (cross & loop)
  - Light Pink (flowers)
  - White (flower)
  - Yellow (flower centers)
  - Green (leaves)
- Crochet hook: 4.0 mm (G-6, USA)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers (optional)



## 2. FINISHED SIZE

Approx. 4.5" (11.5 cm) tall (without loop)  
x 3.5" (9 cm) wide

## 3. ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

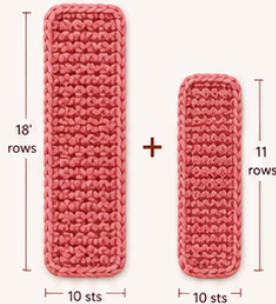
## 4. HOW TO MAKE

### A. CROSS (Make 2 identical pieces)

With Pink yarn

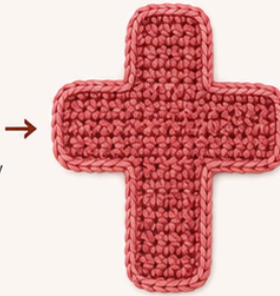
Row 1: ch 11, sc in 2nd ch from hook and across, turn. [10 sts]

Rows 2–18: ch 1, sc across, turn. [10 sts]  
Fasten off.



### B. ASSEMBLE THE CROSS

1. Place the pieces in a cross shape.
2. Whipstitch or slip stitch together at the center (front and back).
3. With Pink yarn, sc evenly around the entire edge for a clean border.



### D. FLOWERS (Make 3)

With Light Pink yarn (Make 2)

1. Ch 4, sl st to form a ring.
2. Ch 2 (does not count as st), 4 dc in ring, sl st in top of ch-2. [5 petals]
3. Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.



With White yarn (Make 1)

1. Ch 4, sl st to form a ring.
2. Ch 2 (does not count as st), 4 dc in ring, sl st in top of ch-2. [5 petals]
3. Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.



### E. FLOWER CENTERS (Make 3)

With Yellow yarn

1. Ch 4, sl st to form a ring.
2. Ch 1, 8 sc in ring, sl st to first sc. [8 sts]
3. Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.



### F. TIRVES (Make 6)

With Green yarn

- Ch 6.
- Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc, dc, hdc, sc.
- Fasten off, leave tail.  
Make 6 leaves.



### C. HANGING LOOP

With Pink yarn

Ch 40 (or desired length).  
Sl st in 2nd ch from hook and across.

Attach the loop to the top of the cross with sl st.

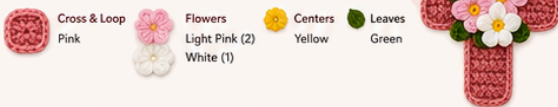

## 7. TIPS

- ♥ Use cotton yarn for durability.
- ♥ Stuff flowers lightly if you want a 3D effect.
- ♥ Weave in all ends neatly.
- ♥ Block your pieces gently for a clean shape.

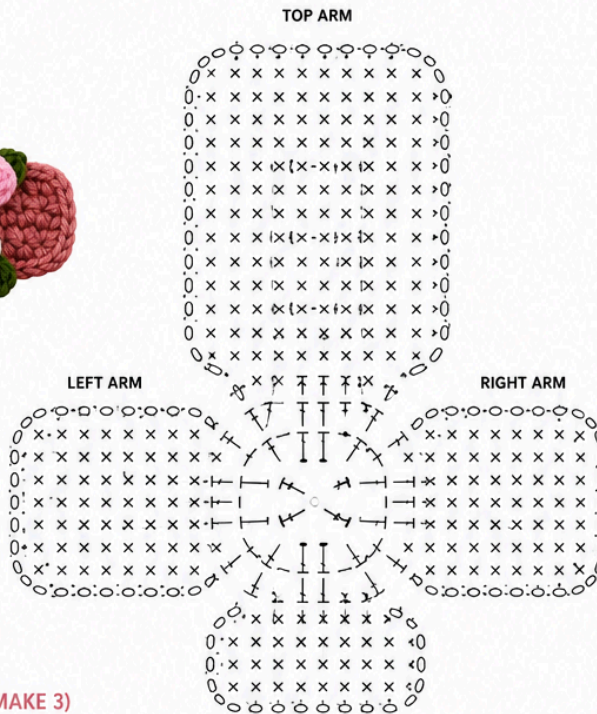

### MATERIALS

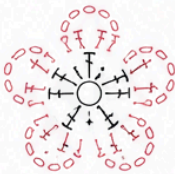
- Worsted weight cotton yarn
  - Pink
  - Dark pink
  - White
  - Yellow
  - Green
- 3.0 mm (C) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

### ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

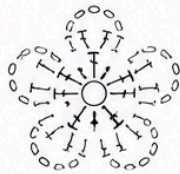
- ch – chain
- sl st – slip stitch
- x sc – single crochet
- T hdc – half double crochet
- T dc – double crochet
- I 2 dc in same stitch
- O picot (ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook)

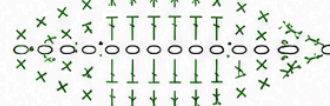

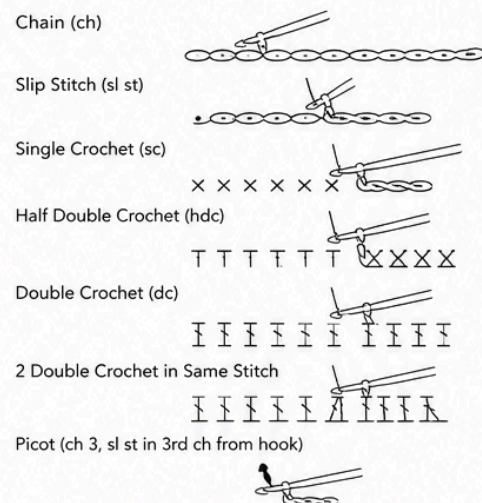

### INSTRUCTIONS

- Cross:** Using pink yarn, ch 11.
  - Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across (10 sc).
  - Rows 2–31: ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across (10 sc).
  - Round the corners: work 3 sc in each corner stitch.
  - Continue sc around the entire cross edge.
  - Fasten off and weave in ends.
- Flowers:**
  - With yellow yarn, make the center for each flower.
  - With pink yarn, make 2 flowers.
  - With white yarn, make 1 flower.
  - Sew the yellow center to each flower.
- Leaves:**
  - Make 6 leaves with green yarn.
- Assembly:**
  - Sew the flowers and leaves to the center of the cross as shown in the photo.
- Hanger:**
  - Make a chain (approx. 25–30 ch) with pink yarn.
  - Attach to the top of the cross. Tie a knot and hide the ends.

# Crochet Flower Cross Car Hanger – Complete Step-by-Step Tutorial

Create a beautiful Crochet Flower Cross Car Hanger with this beginner-friendly pattern! This elegant handmade decoration is perfect for hanging from your car's rearview mirror, giving as a thoughtful gift, or displaying in your home.

This tutorial follows the original pattern closely while expanding every step with detailed explanations so that crocheters in the United States can confidently complete the project from start to finish.

## Materials You'll Need

Before getting started, gather all of your supplies.

### Yarn (Worsted Weight #4 Cotton)

- Pink (Cross and Hanging Loop)
- Light Pink (2 Flowers)
- White (1 Flower)
- Yellow (Flower Centers)
- Green (Leaves)

### Tools

- 4.0 mm (G-6 USA) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Sharp scissors
- Stitch markers (optional but recommended)

**Cotton yarn is highly recommended because it provides excellent stitch definition, durability, and helps the finished cross keep its shape over time.**

## **Finished Size**

**Your completed project should measure approximately:**

- **Height: 4.5 inches (11.5 cm) without the hanging loop**
- **Width: 3.5 inches (9 cm)**

**Measurements may vary slightly depending on your crochet tension.**

## **Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)**

**This tutorial uses US Crochet Terminology.**

<b>ch</b>	<b>chain</b>
<b>sl st</b>	<b>slip stitch</b>
<b>sc</b>	<b>single crochet</b>
<b>hdc</b>	<b>half double crochet</b>

<b>inc</b>	<b>increase (2 stitches in same stitch)</b>
<b>dec</b>	<b>invisible decrease</b>
<b>( )</b>	<b>Repeat instructions</b>

## **Learn the Basic Stitches**

**Before beginning, make sure you're comfortable with these stitches.**

**Chain (ch)**

**Create a slip knot.**

**Yarn over.**

**Pull the yarn through the loop on your hook.**

**Repeat until you reach the required number of chains.**

**Slip Stitch (sl st)**

**Insert your hook into the stitch.**

**Yarn over.**

**Pull through both the stitch and the loop on your hook.**

**This stitch is commonly used for joining pieces.**

**Single Crochet (sc)**

**Insert your hook into the stitch.**

**Yarn over and pull up a loop.**

**Yarn over again.**

**Pull through both loops.**

**Half Double Crochet (hdc)**

**Yarn over.**

**Insert hook into the stitch.**

**Pull up a loop.**

**Yarn over.**

**Pull through all three loops.**

**Double Crochet (dc)**

**Yarn over.**

**Insert hook.**

**Pull up a loop.**

**Yarn over.**

**Pull through two loops.**

**Yarn over again.**

**Pull through the remaining two loops.**

**Increase (inc)**

**Work 2 single crochet stitches into the same stitch.**

**Invisible Decrease (dec)**

**Insert your hook into the front loop of the next stitch.**

**Insert into the front loop of the following stitch.**

**Yarn over.**

**Pull through both front loops.**

**Complete one single crochet.**

**This creates a smooth decrease that is almost invisible.**

**Step 1 – Crochet the Cross Pieces** 

**You will make 2 identical cross pieces.**

**Using Pink yarn:**

**Row 1**

**Chain 11.**

**Work 1 single crochet into the second chain from the hook.**

**Single crochet across.**

**You should have:**

**10 sc**

**Turn your work.**

**Rows 2–18**

**Chain 1.**

**Single crochet across all 10 stitches.**

**Turn.**

**Repeat until you complete 18 rows.**

**Fasten off.**

**Make another identical piece.**

## **Step 2 – Assemble the Cross**

**Lay both cross pieces together with the wrong sides facing each other.**

**Carefully line up every edge.**

**Using your crochet hook and Pink yarn:**

- **Slip stitch or whip stitch the center section together.**
- **Make sure both pieces remain evenly aligned.**
- **Continue sewing around the entire outside edge.**
- **Keep your stitches even for a neat border.**

- Leave the bottom closed only after checking that everything is centered.

The finished cross should be sturdy and hold its shape nicely.

### Step 3 – Make the Hanging Loop 🚗

Using Pink yarn:

Chain 40, or adjust the length if you prefer a shorter or longer hanger.

Slip stitch into the second chain from the hook.

Continue slip stitching across the chain.

Attach both ends securely to the top center of the cross using slip stitches.

Fasten off.

Weave in the yarn ends neatly.

### Step 4 – Crochet the Flowers 🌸

You will make:

- 2 Light Pink Flowers
- 1 White Flower

Light Pink Flowers (Make 2)

Using Light Pink yarn:

Round 1

Chain 4.

Slip stitch into the first chain to form a ring.

Round 2

**Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch).**

**Work:**

- **4 dc**
- **Slip stitch into the top of ch-2**

**Repeat this sequence five times to create 5 petals.**

**Fasten off.**

**Leave a long tail for sewing.**

**White Flower (Make 1)**

**Repeat the exact same instructions using White yarn.**

**You will also create 5 petals.**

**Leave a sewing tail.**

**Step 5 – Crochet the Flower Centers **

**Using Yellow yarn:**

**Make 3 centers.**

**Chain 4.**

**Join with a slip stitch to form a ring.**

**Chain 1.**

**Work 8 single crochet into the ring.**

**Slip stitch into the first stitch.**

**Fasten off.**

**Leave a tail for sewing.**

These small circles will be sewn directly into the center of each flower.

## Step 6 – Crochet the Leaves

Make 6 leaves using Green yarn.

Row 1

Chain 6.

Beginning in the second chain from the hook:

Work:

- sc
- hdc
- dc
- hdc
- sc

Fasten off.

Leave a tail.

Repeat until you have 6 leaves.

## Step 7 – Assemble the Floral Arrangement

Now it's time to decorate the cross.

Arrange:

- Two Light Pink Flowers
- One White Flower
- Three Yellow Centers
- Six Green Leaves

Position the leaves underneath the flowers.

**Place the flowers so they slightly overlap one another.**

**Sew the flower centers onto the middle of each flower.**

**Finally, sew the entire floral arrangement securely onto the center of the cross.**

**Take your time adjusting the placement until everything looks balanced.**

## **Step 8 – Color Placement Guide** 🎨

**Follow this color arrangement for the most attractive result.**

### **Cross**

- **Pink**

### **Hanging Loop**

- **Pink**

### **Flowers**

- **Two Light Pink**
- **One White**

### **Flower Centers**

- **Yellow**

### **Leaves**

- **Green**

**This combination creates a soft, elegant floral look that closely matches the original design.**

## **Step 9 – Finishing Touches** ✨

**Once everything has been sewn together:**

**Inspect all seams.**

**Trim any loose yarn ends.**

**Use a yarn needle to weave in every tail securely.**

**Gently shape the petals with your fingers.**

**Lightly steam-block if desired (avoid overheating cotton yarn).**

**Your cross should now lay flat and have a clean, professional finish.**

### **Helpful Tips**

- **Cotton yarn helps the cross keep its shape better than acrylic.**
- **Keep your stitches consistent for the neatest appearance.**
- **Use stitch markers if you're new to crochet.**
- **Don't pull your sewing stitches too tightly when attaching the flowers.**
- **Block the finished piece gently if needed.**
- **If you'd like a fuller floral arrangement, slightly overlap the flowers before sewing.**
- **Make sure the hanging loop is centered so the cross hangs straight from your rearview mirror.**
