

# Crochet Floral Diamond Pot Holder / Motif



## FINISHED SIZE

Approx. 8.5 in (21.5 cm)  
square (corner to corner)  
(Size may vary depending  
on yarn and tension.)

## MATERIALS

- Worsted Weight Cotton Yarn  
Colors:  
Purple (A) – Main color  
Lavender (B) – Petals  
Yellow (C) – Flower center  
Green (D) – Leaves  
White (E) – Body  
(Small amounts of each)
- Crochet Hook: 4.0 mm (G-6)
- Yarn Needle
- Scissors

## GAUGE

4 dc and 2 rows = 1 in (2.5 cm)  
in double crochet (dc).  
Gauge is not critical for this  
project.

## BASIC STITCHES (US TERMS)

### Chain (ch)



### Slip Stitch (sl st)



### Single Crochet (sc)



### Half Double Crochet (hdc)



### Double Crochet (dc)



### Double Crochet Two Together (dc2tog)



## PATTERN – STEP BY STEP

### 1. FLOWER CENTER

With Yellow (C)  
Ch 4, sl st to first ch  
to form a ring.  
Rnd 1: Ch 1, 8 sc in ring,  
sl st to first sc. (8 sc)



### 2. PETALS (Make 2 Rounds)

Switch to Lavender (B).  
Rnd 1: Ch 1, \*(sc, hdc, 2 dc,  
hdc, sc) in next st, sl st in  
next st\* around.  
(8 petals)  
Rnd 2: Ch 1, \*(sc, hdc, 2 dc,  
hdc, sc) in each petal, sl st  
in next st\* around.



### 3. LEAVES (Make 1 Round)

Switch to Green (D).  
Ch 3, sl st in same st,  
(dc, hdc, sc) in same st,  
sl st in next st.  
Rep from \* around  
to make 8 leaves.



### 4. WHITE BODY (Make 4 Sides)

Switch to White (E). We will work in  
turned rows, starting from one corner.  
**Row 1 (Right Side):** Ch 5 (counts as dc,  
ch 2). Dc in same corner sp, \*ch 2,  
skip next leaf, dc in next leaf sp\*  
3 times, ch 2, dc in same sp.  
Turn.  
**Row 2:** Ch 5, dc in next ch-2 sp,  
\*ch 2, dc in next ch-2 sp\* across  
to corner, ch 2, (dc, ch 2, dc) in  
corner sp. Turn.  
**Row 3:** Ch 5, dc in next ch-2 sp,  
\*ch 2, dc in next ch-2 sp\*  
across to corner, ch 2,  
(dc, ch 2, dc) in corner sp.  
Turn.  
**Row 4:** Rep Row 3.  
**Rows 5–12:** Repeat Rows 3–4  
until you have 12 rows in  
total (adjust for size if needed).  
Fasten off.



### 5. PURPLE SCALLOPED EDGING

Join Purple (A) in any corner.  
Rnd 1: Ch 1, 3 sc in same sp,  
\*sl st in next st or ch-2 sp,  
3 sc in next sp\* around,  
(3 sc, sl st, 3 sc) in  
each corner sp.  
Rnd 2 (Scallops): Ch 1,  
\*sc in first sc, hdc in  
next, dc in next, tr in  
next, dc in next, hdc in  
next, sc in next, sl st in  
next\* around.  
Fasten off and weave in ends.



### 6. HANGING LOOP

Join Purple (A)  
at top corner.  
Ch 20 (or desired length),  
sl st back in 2nd ch  
from hook and in each  
ch across.  
Sl st to the base  
to secure.

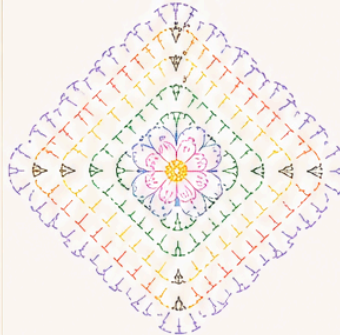

## CROCHET CHART (DIAGRAM)



### Chart Key

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- ⊕ = single crochet (sc)
- ⊥ = half double crochet (hdc)
- ⊥ = double crochet (dc)
- ⊥ = treble crochet (tr)
- ⊥ = dc2tog
- = ch-2 space

## QUICK REFERENCE – MAIN METHODS USED

### Magic Ring

Wrap yarn,  
insert hook,  
pull up a loop,  
ch 1 to secure.



### Chain (ch)

Yarn over,  
pull through  
loop.



### Single Crochet (sc)

Insert hook,  
yarn over,  
pull up a loop,  
yarn over,  
pull through both loops.



### Double Crochet (dc)

Yarn over,  
insert hook,  
yarn over, pull up  
a loop, yarn over,  
pull through two,  
pull through two.



### Treble Crochet (tr)

Yarn over twice,  
insert hook, yarn  
over, pull up a loop,  
(yarn over, pull  
through two) three  
times.



### Slip Stitch (sl st)

Insert hook,  
pull through  
st and loop  
on hook.



### Double Crochet Two Together (dc2tog)

Yarn over,  
insert hook in  
next st, yarn over,  
pull up a loop,  
yarn over, pull through two loops,  
repeat in next st, yarn over,  
pull through all three loops.



## TIPS

- Keep your tension even for straight edges.
- Blocking is optional to even out the shape.
- Use 100% cotton yarn for best absorbency and durability.

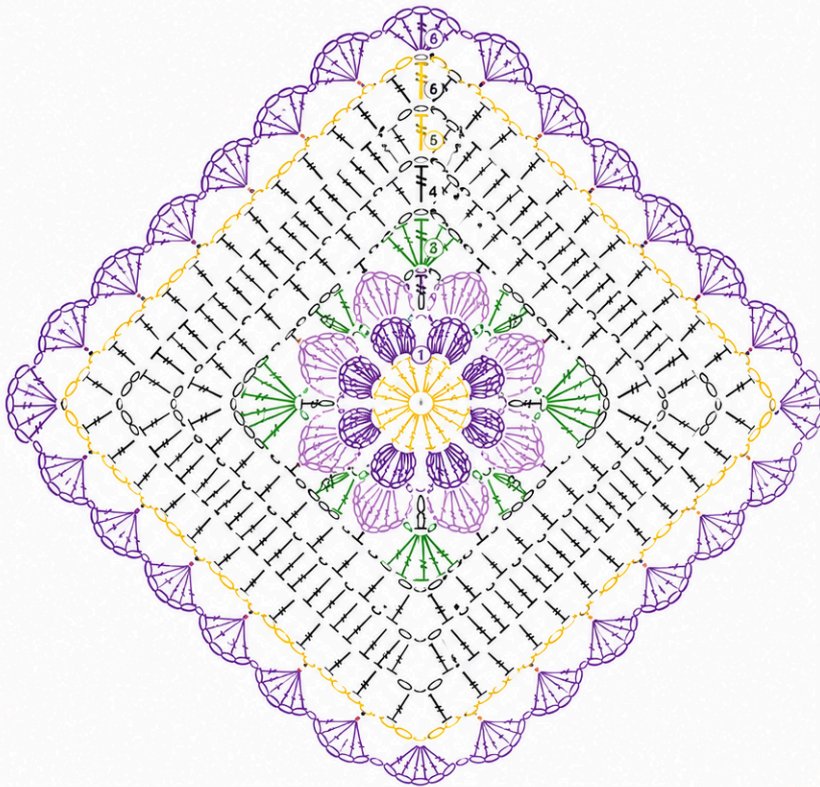
## CARE

Hand wash or machine wash gentle.  
Lay flat to dry.  
Do not bleach.

# FLOWER GRANNY SQUARE – CROCHET CHART



**STITCH LEGEND**

- = Chain (ch)
- = Slip stitch (sl st)
- ⊥ = Double crochet (dc)
- ⊥̄ = Half double crochet (hdc)
- ⊥̄̄ = Treble crochet (tr)
- ⊗ = 3 double crochet cluster (dc cluster)
- ⊗̄ = Shell (5 dc in same st)
- = Magic ring

**COLOR GUIDE (EXAMPLE)**

- Round 1: Yellow
- Round 2: Purple
- Round 3: Green
- Round 4: White
- Round 5: Yellow
- Round 6 (Border): Purple

<p><b>PATTERN NOTES</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The square is worked from the center outward in joined rounds.</li> <li>• Ch 3 at the beginning of a round counts as 1 dc.</li> <li>• Join each round with a slip stitch to the top of the starting chain.</li> <li>• Fasten off and weave in all ends.</li> </ul>	<p><b>ROUND-BY-ROUND GUIDE</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Magic ring, 12 dc, join. (12 dc)</li> <li>2 (dc cluster, ch 1) 12 times, join. (12 clusters)</li> <li>3 (dc cluster, ch 1, dc cluster) in corners, dc in between, join. (4 corners)</li> <li>4 Granny pattern: 3 dc clusters in corners, ch 1 between groups, join.</li> <li>5 Repeat round 4 with color change.</li> <li>6 Shell border: 5 dc in each side space, (5 dc, ch 1, 5 dc) in corners, join.</li> </ol>
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**YARN SUGGESTION**

Cotton yarn  
( Light / DK weight )  
Smooth and soft yarn works best for definition.

## Crochet Floral Diamond Pot Holder / Motif Tutorial

This Crochet Floral Diamond Pot Holder / Motif is made with a colorful flower center, green leaves, a white diamond body, purple scalloped edging, and a hanging loop. The instructions

below use US crochet terms and follow the chart tutorial closely.

## **Materials**

**Worsted weight cotton yarn in:**

**Purple — main color**

**Lavender — petals**

**Yellow — flower center**

**Green — leaves**

**White — body**

**You will also need:**

**4.0 mm crochet hook**

**Yarn needle**

**Scissors**

**Finished size: about 8.5 in / 21.5 cm square, measured corner to corner.**

**Gauge: about 4 dc and 2 rows = 1 inch in double crochet.**

**Gauge is not critical.**

## **Abbreviations**

**ch = chain**

**sl st = slip stitch**

**sc = single crochet**

**hdc = half double crochet**

**dc = double crochet**

**tr = treble crochet**

**dc2tog = double crochet two together**

**sp = space**

**st/sts = stitch/stitches**

## **Step 1: Flower Center** 🌻

Using yellow yarn, make a magic ring.

Ch 4, then work 5 sl st into the first chain to form a small ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, work 8 sc into the ring. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

You should now have a small yellow flower center with 8 stitches.

Fasten off or keep the yarn if needed, then weave in the tail neatly.

## **Step 2: Lavender Petals**

Join lavender yarn to any stitch of the yellow center.

Round 1: Ch 1. In the same stitch, work:

sc, hdc, 2 dc, hdc, sc

This forms one petal.

Repeat this same petal pattern in each stitch around.

You will make 8 petals total.

Join with a sl st at the end of the round.

Round 2: Ch 1. In each petal, work:

sc, hdc, 2 dc, hdc, sc

Repeat around to make the petals fuller and more rounded.

Join with a sl st and fasten off.

## **Step 3: Green Leaves** 🌿

**Join green yarn between the petals.**

**Round 1: Ch 3, sl st in the same stitch.**

**Then work:**

**dc, hdc, sc**

**in the same space to shape the first leaf.**

**Sl st into the next space between petals.**

**Repeat around until you have 8 green leaves.**

**Fasten off and weave in the ends.**

#### **Step 4: White Diamond Body**

**Join white yarn in one corner area of the flower/leaf center.**

**The white body is worked in turned rows, starting from one corner and growing into a diamond shape.**

**Row 1: Ch 5. In the same corner space, work:**

**dc, ch 2, skip next leaf, dc in next leaf space**

**Repeat this structure across the row. Turn.**

**Row 2: Ch 5. Work dc into the next ch-2 space.**

**Continue working:**

**ch 2, dc in next ch-2 space**

**until you reach the corner.**

**In the corner space, work:**

**dc, ch 2, dc**

**Turn.**

**Row 3: Repeat Row 2, increasing at the corner.**

**Continue working open mesh rows with ch-2 spaces and dc stitches.**

**Rows 4–5: Repeat the same pattern.**

**Rows 6–12: Continue repeating Rows 3–4 until the white body reaches about 12 rows total, or until the motif is the size you want.**

**Keep the diamond shape even and flat. Do not pull the chains too tightly.**

**Fasten off and weave in the ends.**

### **Step 5: Purple Scalloped Edging**

**Join purple yarn in any corner.**

**Round 1: Ch 1. Work 3 sc in the same corner space.**

**Work sc evenly around the white diamond, placing stitches into the chain spaces and along the edges.**

**In each corner, work:**

**3 sc, sl st, 3 sc**

**Join with a sl st to finish the round.**

**Round 2: Ch 1.**

**For the scallops, repeat around:**

**sc in first stitch, hdc in next stitch, dc in next stitch, tr in next stitch, dc in next stitch, hdc in next stitch, sc in next stitch**

**This creates the rounded purple scalloped border.**

**Continue around the entire motif.**

**Join with a sl st.**

**Fasten off and weave in all ends.**

## **Step 6: Hanging Loop**

**Join purple yarn at the top corner.**

**Ch 20, or longer if you want a larger hanging loop.**

**Sl st back into the second chain from the hook and into each chain across.**

**Sl st to the base of the loop to secure it firmly.**

**Fasten off and weave in the tail.**

## **Finishing**

**Block the motif gently so the diamond shape looks clean and even.**

**Lay it flat, shape the corners, and let it dry completely.**

**Your Crochet Floral Diamond Pot Holder / Motif is ready! 🌸💜**

**Use it as a decorative pot holder, table accent, wall hanging, or handmade gift.**
