



Diamond Flower Crochet Dress



Step-by-Step Tutorial



About the Dress

This dress is made from diamond motifs with 3D flower centers joined together and connected with a lattice mesh. It has adjustable straps and side ties for the perfect fit. The pattern is worked in the round for each motif and joined as you go.

Materials

- Medium (4) weight cotton yarn in 4 colors: A, B, C, D
- Color A (Yellow) - approx. 250 g
- Color B (Aqua) - approx. 200 g
- Color C (Pink) - approx. 200 g
- Color D (Purple) - approx. 200 g
- Crochet hook 5.0 mm (H)
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers
- Measuring tape (optional)

Gauge

1 diamond motif = approx. 6.5" (16.5 cm) corner to corner
Flower = approx. 1.5" (4 cm) diameter
Gauge is not critical for this project.

Basic Stitches (US Terms)

Chain (ch)	Slip Stitch (sl st)	Single Crochet (sc)	Half Double Crochet (hdc)	Double Crochet (dc)	Treble Crochet (tr)	Double Treble (dtr)	Picot (optional)
Yarn over (yo) and pull through loop on hook.	Insert hook into st, yo and pull through both loops.	Insert hook, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through both loops.	Yo, insert hook, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through all 3 loops.	Yo, insert hook, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull through 2 loops.	Yo 2 times, insert hook, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops 3 times.	Yo 3 times, insert hook, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops 4 times.	Ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook.

How to Make – Step by Step

1 Make the Flower Center

(Make 5 petals per flower)

With flower color, ch 4.
Join with sl st to form a ring.
Round 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring.
Join with sl st. (10 sts)
Round 2: *Ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook (picot), sl st in next st.* Repeat * to * 5 times. Fasten off, leave a tail to sew.



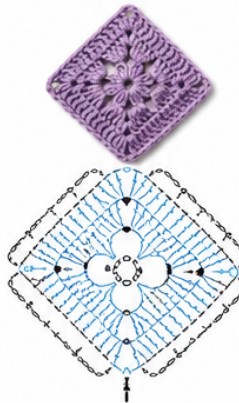

2 Make the Diamond Motif

(Worked from center outward)

With main color (A, B, C or D)
Ch 4. Join with sl st to form a ring.
Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in ring, ch 2. *3 dc, ch 2* in ring 3 more times. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. (4 clusters)
Round 2: Sl st in ch-2 sp. Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in same sp. (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in each ch-2 sp around. Join with sl st. (4 corners)
Round 3: Sl st in ch-2 sp. Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in same sp. Work 3 dc in each dc across side to next corner. In corner ch-2 sp work (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc). Repeat around. Join with sl st.
Round 4: Sl st in ch-2 sp. Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in same sp. Work 1 dc in each dc to next corner. In corner ch-2 sp work (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc). Repeat around. Join with sl st. Fasten off.



3 Make All Motifs

Make the following number of diamonds (example layout):
Center front & back: 3 purple
Upper sides: 4 aqua
Middle sides: 4 pink
Lower sides: 4 yellow
Total: 15 diamonds
Sew a flower in the center of each diamond.



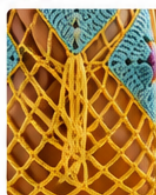
4 Join the Diamonds

Join motifs as you go using sl stitches at the corners and along the sides to form the front and back panels.
Layout the diamonds as shown in the photo or customize to your size. Make sure the top forms a V-shape.



5 Create the Lattice Mesh

With yellow yarn.
Row 1: Attach yarn at any corner. Ch 8, sl st in next corner space. *Ch 8, sl st in next corner space.* Repeat across to form diamond mesh between motifs.
Row 2: Ch 8, sl st in center of next ch-8 loop. Repeat across. Continue until entire dress is connected with lattice.



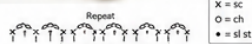
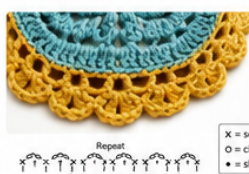
6 Straps and Side Ties

Straps: With yellow yarn, make 2 long chains (approx. 60-70 sts), work 1 row of sl st back along chain for strength. Attach to top corners.
Side ties: Make chains (approx. 80-100 sts), work sl st row and weave through side mesh at waist level.



7 Bottom Edge

With yellow yarn.
Round 1: Attach yarn at bottom edge. Ch 1, sc evenly across all bottom edge.
Round 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, *ch 3, skip 2 sts, sc in next st.* Repeat around.
Round 3: Ch 1, sc in each st and in each ch-3 space. Fasten off.



Main Techniques Used

- Working in the round
- Cluster stitches (3 dc clusters)
- Picot for flower petals
- Joining motifs with slip stitch
- Chain space lattice mesh
- Edging with shells and chains

Yarn and Color Suggestions

A - Yellow (main/lattice)
B - Aqua
C - Pink
D - Purple

Choose colors you love and make it your own!



Care Instructions

- Hand wash in cold water
- Lay flat to dry
- Do not bleach
- Do not wring
- Store folded

CROCHET DIAMOND SQUARE DRESS

Granny square and mesh crochet dress with floral center

MATERIALS

- Medium weight cotton yarn
- Colors:
 - Yellow
 - Turquoise
 - Pink
 - Purple
 - Mint (flower center)
- Crochet hook: 3.5 mm (E-4)
- Scissors, yarn needle

STITCH KEY (US TERMS)

- = Chain (ch)
- = Slip stitch (sl st)
- ⊕ = Single crochet (sc)
- ⌞ = Half double crochet (hdc)
- ⌚ = Double crochet (dc)
- ⌚⌚ = Treble crochet (tr)
- ⊖ = Picot (ch 3, sl st in 1st ch)

HOOK GUIDE

3.5 mm (E-4)



GAUGE

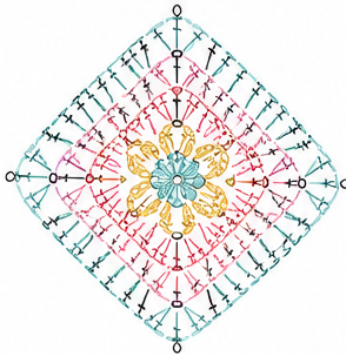
One square =
about 10 cm / 4 in
(blocked)

FLORAL CENTER (Make 1)



- 1) With Mint, ch 6, sl st in first ch to form a ring.
- 2) Ch 2, 11 dc in ring, sl st into top of beginning ch 2. Fasten off.
- 3) Join Yellow in any dc, (ch 2, 2 dc, ch 2, sl st) in same st. Repeat in each st around. Fasten off.

DIAMOND SQUARE (Make 22 total)



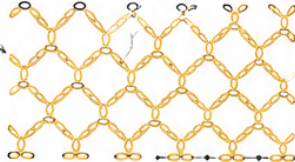
Join new color in any corner space.

Round 1 (around flower):
Ch 3 (counts as dc),
2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc
in same space (corner).
*3 dc in next dc,
(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc)
in next space (corner).
Repeat from * 3 more
times. Join with sl st
to top of beginning ch 3.
(4 corners)

Round 2: Sl st to corner
space, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2,
3 dc in same space.
*3 dc in each dc
across to next corner*
space, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc)
in corner space.
Repeat from * 3 more
times. Join. Fasten off.
Weave in ends.

MESH NET (Make continuous)

Ch 5, skip 2 sts,
sl st in next st
to form a loop.
*Ch 5, skip 2 sts,
sl st in next st.*
Repeat across
every row.
This creates
the net.



MEASUREMENTS (approx.)

- Bust: 80–90 cm / 31.5–35.5 in (adjust with ties)
- Length: 70–80 cm / 27.5–31.5 in (adjust mesh rows)
- One size (adjustable)



ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM

Make 2 triangles
(same as half square)
for bust cups.
Join with mesh
at center front.

Strap:
Ch approx. 60–70 sts
(adjust to fit),
sl st back.

Tie sides:
Ch approx. 60–70 sts
on each side.

Join squares
with mesh
as shown.

Continue mesh
down to hem.



BORDER / HEM



Row 1: Attach yarn at hem,
ch 1, sc evenly around.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc),
dc in each sc around.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each dc around.
Fasten off. Weave in ends.

TIPS

- Block all squares before joining.
- Adjust strap and side tie length for best fit.
- Use lightweight cotton for a perfect drape.

ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

ch: chain
sl st: slip stitch
sc: single crochet
hdc: half double crochet
dc: double crochet
tr: treble crochet

Diamond Flower Crochet Dress – Complete Step-by-Step Tutorial (US Terms)



Create a beautiful Diamond Flower Crochet Dress using colorful diamond motifs joined together with an open lattice mesh. This tutorial is based on the reference design shown in the diagram and is written using US crochet terminology. Every step is explained in detail so beginners with basic crochet experience, as well as intermediate crocheters, can successfully complete the project.

The dress is worked by making individual diamond granny motifs, crocheting small 3D flowers, joining the motifs as you go, adding the decorative lattice mesh, and finally finishing with straps, side ties, and a scalloped border.

The construction is very flexible. You can easily adjust the size by adding or removing motifs before assembling the dress.

Materials

You will need:

- Medium (4) Weight Cotton Yarn
- Color A – Yellow (Main lattice and flowers) – approximately 250 g
- Color B – Aqua – approximately 200 g
- Color C – Pink – approximately 200 g
- Color D – Purple – approximately 200 g
- Crochet Hook 5.0 mm (H)
- Tapestry Needle

- **Stitch Markers**
- **Measuring Tape**
- **Sharp Scissors**

Cotton yarn is highly recommended because it provides excellent stitch definition and keeps the dress lightweight for warm weather.

Abbreviations (US Crochet Terms)

- **ch = chain**
- **sl st = slip stitch**
- **sc = single crochet**
- **hdc = half double crochet**
- **dc = double crochet**
- **dc2tog = double crochet two together**
- **tr = treble crochet**
- **dtr = double treble crochet**
- **sp = space**
- **st = stitch**
- **rep = repeat**
- **yo = yarn over**

Gauge

One completed diamond motif measures approximately:

- **6½ inches (16.5 cm) from corner to corner**

Each flower measures approximately:

- **1½ inches (4 cm)**

Exact gauge is not critical, but all motifs should be made consistently using the same tension.

Finished Layout

The sample dress uses 15 diamond motifs.

Suggested color arrangement:

Center:

- **3 Purple**

Upper Section:

- **4 Aqua**

Middle Section:

- **4 Pink**

Lower Section:

- **4 Yellow**

Feel free to rearrange the colors to create your own unique design.

Step 1 – Learn the Basic Crochet Stitches

Before beginning, make sure you are comfortable with these stitches.

Chain (ch)

Yarn over and pull through the loop already on the hook.

Chains create the foundation of your crochet fabric.

Slip Stitch (sl st)

Insert the hook into the stitch.

Yarn over.

Pull through the stitch and immediately through the loop on your hook.

Used for joining rounds and moving between stitches.

Single Crochet (sc)

Insert hook.

Yarn over.

Pull up one loop.

Yarn over again.

Pull through both loops.

Half Double Crochet (hdc)

Yarn over.

Insert hook.

Pull up a loop.

Yarn over.

Pull through all three loops.

Double Crochet (dc)

Yarn over.

Insert hook.

Pull up a loop.

Yarn over.

Pull through two loops.

Yarn over.

Pull through remaining two loops.

Treble Crochet (tr)

Yarn over twice.

Insert hook.

Pull up a loop.

Yarn over.

Pull through two loops three separate times.

Double Treble Crochet (dtr)

Yarn over three times.

Insert hook.

Pull up a loop.

Yarn over and pull through two loops four separate times.

Picot

Chain 3.

Slip stitch into the first chain.

This creates a decorative little point used on flower petals.

Step 2 – Crochet the 3D Flower Center 🌻

Make 15 flowers.

Round 1

Create a magic ring.

Chain 1.

Work 10 single crochet into the ring.

Join with a slip stitch.

Round 2

Chain 3.

Work:

- 3 dc
- picot
- slip stitch into the next stitch

Repeat around five times.

You now have five petals.

Fasten off.

Leave a long sewing tail.

Set aside.

Step 3 – Crochet the Diamond Motif ♦

Each dress requires 15 motifs.

Foundation

Chain 4.

Join with a slip stitch to form a ring.

Round 1

Chain 3 (counts as first dc).

Work:

- 2 dc
- ch 2

Repeat:

3 dc

ch 2

three more times.

Join.

You now have four corners.

Round 2

Slip stitch into the corner.

Chain 3.

Work:

2 dc

ch 2

3 dc

into every corner.

Between corners:

3 dc.

Join.

Round 3

Slip stitch to the next corner.

Work:

3 dc

ch 2

3 dc

inside every corner.

Work one 3-dc cluster inside every side space.

Join.

Round 4

Repeat the previous round.

Continue increasing evenly.

Maintain square symmetry while the shape naturally forms a diamond.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Repeat until all motifs are finished.

Step 4 – Attach the Flowers

Place one flower in the center opening of every diamond.

Using the yarn tail:

Sew through the center securely.

Make several stitches on the back.

Hide the yarn tail inside the motif.

Repeat for all motifs.

Step 5 – Arrange the Motifs

Lay all diamonds on a flat table.

Suggested arrangement:

Top Row:

- **2 Aqua**

Second Row:

- 1 Purple
- 2 Pink

Third Row:

- 2 Aqua
- 2 Pink

Fourth Row:

- 2 Yellow
- 2 Aqua

Bottom Row:

- 2 Yellow

Adjust spacing until everything looks balanced.

Step 6 – Join the Diamonds

Using slip stitches:

Hold two motifs with right sides facing up.

Insert the hook through matching stitches.

Slip stitch across the entire edge.

Repeat for every joining edge.

Continue until:

- Front panel is complete.
- Back panel is complete.

Then join both panels at the shoulders and sides.

Leave the side openings for the decorative lacing.

Step 7 – Create the Decorative Lattice Mesh

Using Yellow yarn.

Attach yarn at one corner.

Row 1

Chain 5.

Skip one edge space.

Single crochet into the next space.

Repeat all around the open areas.

Row 2

Slip stitch into first chain space.

Chain 5.

Single crochet into next chain space.

Repeat.

Continue adding lattice rows until the open areas between motifs are completely filled.

The lattice should remain loose and flexible.

Do not pull the chains tightly.

Step 8 – Shape the Dress

Try on the dress.

Adjust fit if necessary.

If more width is needed:

Add another vertical column of motifs.

If more length is desired:

Add another horizontal row.

The modular construction makes resizing extremely easy.

Step 9 – Crochet the Shoulder Straps

Attach yarn at the upper front corner.

Chain approximately 60–70 stitches.

Check the desired strap length.

Single crochet back across the chain.

Fasten off.

Repeat for the second strap.

Sew each strap securely to the back panel.

Step 10 – Create the Side Ties

Attach yarn at each side opening.

Chain approximately 80–100 stitches.

Slip stitch back along the chain for a smooth cord.

Repeat for the opposite side.

Thread the ties through the side lattice.

Tie into decorative bows.

Step 11 – Crochet the Bottom Border

Attach yellow yarn to the lower edge.

Round 1

Single crochet evenly around.

Round 2

Repeat:

- ch 5
- skip 2 stitches
- sc

around the edge.

Round 3

Work shell stitches inside every chain space:

(sc, hdc, 3 dc, hdc, sc)

Repeat all around.

Join.

Fasten off.

This creates the elegant scalloped edge shown in the original design.

Step 12 – Finishing

Carefully weave in every yarn end.

Steam block or wet block the dress.

Allow it to dry completely before wearing.

Blocking helps the motifs open beautifully and gives the dress its final professional appearance.

Care Instructions

- Hand wash in cold water.
- Use mild detergent.
- Do not bleach.

- Do not wring.
- Lay flat to dry.
- Store folded instead of hanging.
- Avoid prolonged direct sunlight to preserve the colors.

Helpful Tips ✨

- Make all motifs before assembly to ensure consistent sizing.
- Count stitches at the end of every round.
- Keep the same crochet tension throughout the project.
- Use stitch markers at every corner if needed.
- Weave in ends as you go to make finishing much easier.
- Try on the dress several times during assembly to customize the fit.
