



CROCHET VIRGIN DOLL

Step-by-Step Tutorial

Beautiful amigurumi doll with rose-trimmed cloak

1. MATERIALS

- Sport (2) or DK (3) weight yarn
- Colors:
Skin (beige), Hair (brown),
Dress (peach), Cloak (green),
Roses (pink), Leaves (green),
Embroidery thread (red, green, yellow)
- 2.25 mm (B) crochet hook
- 10 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Yarn needle, scissors, stitch markers
- Hot glue (optional)
- Small cross charm or make one with yarn

2. FINISHED SIZE

Approx. 23 cm (9 in) tall



3. ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

MR	Magic Ring	hdc	half double crochet
ch	chain	hdc	double crochet
sl st	slip stitch	dc	double crochet
sc	single crochet	tr	treble crochet
inc	increase (2 sc in next st)	st(s)	stitch(es)
dec	decrease (sc 2 together)	FO	fasten off

4. BASIC STITCHES (US)



Chain (ch)



Slip Stitch (sl st)



Single Crochet (sc)



Half Double Crochet (hdc)



Double Crochet (dc)



Treble Crochet (tr)

5. STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

A. HEAD (Beige)

Start in MR and work in continuous rounds.

- R1: 6 sc in MR (6)
R2: inc around (12)
R3: (sc, inc) x6 (18)
R4: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)
R5: (3 sc, inc) x6 (30)
R6-11: sc around (30)
R12: (3 sc, dec) x6 (24)
R13: (2 sc, dec) x6 (18)
Insert eyes between R8-9 about 6 sts apart.
R14: (sc, dec) x6 (12)
R15: dec x6 (6) FO.
Embroider smile and eyebrows.



D. ARMS (Make 2)

- R1: 6 sc in MR (6)
R2-5: sc around (6)
Flatten and sl st closed.



E. HANDS (Make 2)

- R1: 5 sc in MR (5)
R2-3: sc around (5)
Attach to arms.



G. CLOAK (Green)

Ch 90.

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and across.

Rows 2-22: ch 1, turn, sc across.

Work border around cloak with yellow yarn: sl st or sc.



H. HOOD

Attach cloak at neck.
Sc evenly around face opening to shape hood.
Sew roses and leaves around the hood.



B. HAIR (Brown)

Attach yarn at top center.

R1: ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each st around.

Make strands: cut yarn pieces, fold in half and attach to head.



F. DRESS (Peach)

Attach to body.

- R1: BLO sc around (24)
R2-3: sc around (24)
R4: (3 sc, inc) x6 (30)
R5-9: sc around (30)
R10: (4 sc, inc) x6 (36)
R11-16: sc around (36)
Embroider decorative flowers and branches.



C. BODY (Peach)

- R1: 6 sc in MR (6)
R2: inc around (12)
R3: (sc, inc) x6 (18)
R4: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)
R5-7: sc around (24)
Stuff firmly.



I. ASSEMBLY

- Sew head to body.
- Attach arms to sides.
- Place cloak over shoulders and sew at neck.
- Add cross (make with yarn or use small charm).
- Add roses and leaves on hood and hem.



6. ROSES (Make 7)

Ch 35.

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and across.

Row 2: ch 1, turn, (hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc, sl st) in same st, sl st in next st, repeat to end.

Roll and sew to form rose.



7. LEAVES (Make 14)

Ch 8.

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc, dc, hdc, sc, sl st.

Row 2: sl st, sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc. FO, leave long tail. Sew around roses.



8. CROSS (Optional)

Ch 10.

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and across.

Make 2 pieces. Sew together in cross shape. Attach to hands.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS



Hand wash with mild soap



Do not bleach



Dry flat



Do not iron



Store in a dry, clean place

MR	Magic Ring
ch	Chain
sc	Single Crochet
inc	Increase (2 sc in next st)
dec	Decrease (sc2tog)
hdc	Half Double Crochet
dc	Double Crochet
sl st	Slip Stitch
BLO	Back Loop Only
FLO	Front Loop Only
(...)	Repeat instructions
[]	Total stitches

MATERIALS

- Cotton yarn (DK / Light Worsted)
 - Skin color
 - Brown
 - Peach / Pink
 - Green (cloak)
 - Yellow (stars & edging)
 - Pink (roses)
 - Green (leaves)
 - Brown (rosary)
- 2.5 mm crochet hook
- Safety eyes 10 mm
- Fiberfill
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers
- Embroidery thread (red, green)
- Hot glue (optional)

HOOKS GUIDE

2.5 mm
(US C/2)
Use a smaller hook
for tighter stitches
and neat shaping.

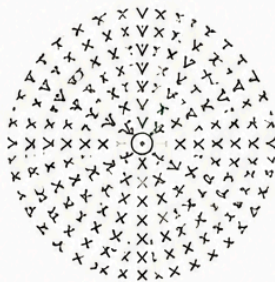


HEAD (Skin Color)

Work in continuous rounds.

Rnd	Stitches	
1	MR 6 sc	[6]
2	inc around	[12]
3	(sc, inc) x6	[18]
4	(2 sc, inc) x6	[24]
5	(3 sc, inc) x6	[30]
6	(4 sc, inc) x6	[36]
7-13	sc around (7 rnds)	[36]
14	(4 sc, dec) x6	[30]
15	(3 sc, dec) x6	[24]
16	(2 sc, dec) x6	[18]
17	(sc, dec) x6	[12]
18	dec x6	[6]

Fasten off, close the hole.



HAIR (Brown)

Attach yarn to front of head.
Make hair strands.

Ch 20, sl st in 2nd ch from
hook, sl st across.

Make several
glue or sew on.



ARMS (Make 2)

(Skin Color)

Rnd	Stitches	
1	MR 6 sc	[6]
2-6	sc around (5 rnds)	[6]
7	Fasten off and sc 3 across	[3]



BODY / DRESS (Peach/Pink)

Work in continuous rounds.

Rnd	Stitches	
1	MR 6 sc	[6]
2	inc around	[12]
3	(sc, inc) x6	[18]
4	(2 sc, inc) x6	[24]
5	(3 sc, inc) x6	[30]
6-18	sc around (13 rnds)	[30]
19	(3 sc, dec) x6	[24]
20	(2 sc, dec) x6	[18]
21	(sc, dec) x6	[12]
22	dec x6	[6]

Fasten off.



ROSARY (Brown)

Make a chain

Ch 20.

In 6th ch from hook,
make a cross:

Row 1: sc 6
Row 2: sc 4
Fasten off.



CLOAK (Green with Yellow Stars)

Start from top center back.

Ch 81.

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook
and across.

Row 2-30: ch 1, turn, sc across.
(30 rows)

Edging (Yellow):

Rnd 1: sc around entire cloak.
Rnd 2: crab stitch (reverse sc).

Embroider stars with
yellow thread.



FLOWERS (Pink) Make 7

Ch 30.

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook
and across.

Roll into a spiral.

Sew the base.



LEAVES (Green) Make 14

Ch 8.

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook,
hdc, dc, hdc, sc, sl st.

Fasten off.



ASSEMBLY

- Sew the head to the body.
- Attach arms to the sides.
- Sew or glue hair on the head.
- Place the cloak on the doll.
- Attach flowers and leaves around the hood and bottom of the cloak.
- Embroider dress details with red and green thread.
- Place the rosary in the hands and sew.



EMBROIDERY GUIDE (Dress)

Use embroidery thread
to make the floral design.



FINISHED SIZE

Approx. 23-25 cm
(9-10 inches)

TIPS

- Use stitch markers to keep track of rounds.
- Stuff firmly for a nice shape.
- You can adjust the size using thinner yarn and a smaller hook.

Crochet Virgin Doll – Complete Step-by-Step Tutorial (US Terms)

Create a beautiful handmade **Crochet Virgin Doll** with a detailed floral cloak, embroidered dress, delicate roses, and a removable hood. This tutorial follows the same construction sequence shown in the reference chart while expanding every step with detailed explanations so that beginners and experienced crocheters in the United States can confidently complete the project from start to finish.

The pattern uses **US crochet terminology** and is written in continuous rounds unless otherwise noted.

Finished Size: **Approximately 23 cm (9 inches)**



Materials

Prepare all materials before beginning.

You will need:

- Sport Weight (2) or DK Weight (3) yarn
- Skin color (Beige)
- Brown yarn
- Peach yarn
- Dark Green yarn
- Light Pink yarn
- Leaf Green yarn
- Yellow embroidery thread or fine yarn
- Red embroidery thread
- Green embroidery thread
- Brown embroidery thread

Notions:

- 2.25 mm (B) crochet hook
- Pair of 10 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers
- Small scissors
- Sewing pins

- Hot glue (optional)
- Small cross charm (optional)



Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)

MR = Magic Ring

ch = chain

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

tr = treble crochet

inc = increase

dec = invisible decrease

st = stitch

sts = stitches

FO = fasten off



Basic Crochet Stitches

Before starting, make sure you know these stitches.

Chain (ch)

Wrap the yarn over the hook and pull through the loop.

Chains create the foundation of many crochet pieces.

Slip Stitch (sl st)

Insert hook.

Yarn over.

Pull through stitch and loop on hook.

Used for joining and finishing.

Single Crochet (sc)

Insert hook.

Yarn over.

Pull up loop.

Yarn over.

Pull through both loops.

Half Double Crochet (hdc)

Yarn over.

Insert hook.

Pull up loop.

Yarn over.

Pull through all three loops.

Double Crochet (dc)

Yarn over.

Insert hook.

Pull up loop.

Yarn over.

Pull through two loops.

Yarn over.

Pull through remaining two loops.

Treble Crochet (tr)

Yarn over twice.

Insert hook.

Pull up loop.

Yarn over.

Pull through two loops three times.

Head

Begin the Head

Using beige yarn:

Work in continuous rounds.

Round 1

6 sc in MR.

(6)

Round 2

Inc in every stitch.

(12)

Round 3

(sc, inc) ×6

(18)

Round 4

(2 sc, inc) ×6

(24)

Round 5

(3 sc, inc) ×6

(30)

Rounds 6–11

30 sc.

Stuff gradually while crocheting.

Round 12

(3 sc, dec) ×6

(24)

Round 13

24 sc.

Insert the safety eyes between Rounds 8 and 9.

Leave approximately six stitches between the eyes.

Embroider:

- Eyebrows
- Smile
- Rosy cheeks
- Small eyelashes if desired

Round 14

(2 sc, dec) ×6

(18)

Continue stuffing firmly.

Round 15

(sc, dec) ×6

(12)

FO leaving a long sewing tail.

Body

Crochet the Body

Using peach yarn:

Round 1

6 sc in MR.

Round 2

Increase around.

(12)

Round 3

(sc, inc) around.

(18)

Round 4

(2 sc, inc) around.

(24)

Rounds 5–7

24 sc.

Stuff firmly.

Leave long tail.

Hair

Make the Hair Cap

Using brown yarn:

Crochet a cap large enough to fit the head snugly.

Attach securely.

Cut multiple strands of brown yarn.

Fold each strand in half.

Attach around the cap using a latch-hook method or crochet hook.

Trim evenly.

Arrange the bangs around the face.

Lightly tack the hair into place using a few hidden stitches.

Arms

Crochet Two Arms

Using beige yarn:

Round 1

6 sc in MR.

Rounds 2–5

6 sc.

Lightly stuff only the lower portion.

Flatten the top.

Close with a few stitches.

Leave long tails.

Hands

Crochet Two Hands

Using beige yarn.

Round 1

5 sc in MR.

Rounds 2–3

5 sc.

Fasten off.

Sew onto the ends of the arms.

Dress

Crochet the Dress

Using peach yarn:

Work from the neckline downward.

Round 1

BLO 24 sc.

Rounds 2–3

24 sc.

Round 4

(3 sc, inc) ×6

(30)

Rounds 5–9

30 sc.

Round 10

(4 sc, inc) ×6

(36)

Rounds 11–16

36 sc.

Fasten off.

Embroider the Dress

Using red embroidery thread:

Create vertical stems.

Add branches.

Using green thread:

Add leaves.

Using small French knots or satin stitches:

Create tiny flowers.

Keep the embroidery symmetrical.

Cloak

Crochet the Green Cloak

Using green yarn:

Foundation

Chain 90.

Row 1

Single crochet across.

Rows 2–22

Chain 1.

Turn.

Single crochet across.

Create gentle shaping by decreasing near the neckline if desired.

Decorative Border

Using yellow yarn:

Crochet one complete round around the cloak.

Use:

- Slip stitches
- Single crochet edging
- Picot edging (optional)

Embroider tiny yellow stars evenly across the cloak.

Hood

Crochet the Hood

Fold the upper portion of the cloak.

Sew the back seam.

Leave the front open.

Try the hood on the doll before permanently sewing.

Adjust until it frames the face naturally.

Rose Decoration

Using pink yarn.

Make seven roses.

Foundation

Chain 35.

Row 1

Single crochet across.

Row 2

Create petals using combinations of:

- hdc
- dc
- tr

Roll tightly.

Sew securely.

Leaves

Crochet Fourteen Leaves

Using green yarn.

Foundation

Chain 8.

Row

Work around the chain:

sc

hdc

dc

hdc

sc

sl st

Fasten off.

Leave long tails.

Cross

Optional Cross

Using brown yarn.

Chain 10.

Single crochet across.

Create:

One long strip.

One shorter strip.

Sew together into a cross.

Attach between the doll's folded hands or use a miniature wooden or metal cross charm.

Assembly

Assemble the Doll

Sew the head securely onto the body.

Attach the arms evenly.

Sew the hands.

Dress the doll.

Attach the cloak.

Attach the hood.

Position the roses evenly around the hood.

Sew leaves underneath each rose.

Place several roses around the bottom edge of the cloak.

Secure every piece with hidden stitches.

Finishing Details

Face Details

Embroider:

- Smile
- Nose
- Eyebrows
- Eyelashes

Apply blush using soft pink fabric paint or cosmetic blush.

Final Shaping

Massage the stuffing to remove bumps.

Adjust the cloak.

Arrange the roses.

Steam lightly if necessary.

Do not iron directly.

Care Instructions



Hand wash only with mild soap.



Do not bleach.

 Lay flat to dry.

 Do not tumble dry.

 Do not iron directly.

 Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

Tips for Best Results

Keep Even Tension

Consistent stitch tension produces a smooth, professional finish.

Stuff Gradually

Never overstuff.

Add small amounts of fiberfill throughout the project.

Use Stitch Markers

Mark the first stitch of every round.

This prevents losing your place.

Sew Carefully

Pin all pieces before sewing permanently.

Always check the doll from every angle for symmetry.

Embroidery Tips

Keep flower stems centered.

Space roses evenly.

Hide all yarn tails inside the doll for a clean finish.

Finished Doll

Your finished **Crochet Virgin Doll** should measure approximately **23 cm (9 inches)** tall and feature:

- 🌹 Seven pink roses
- 🌿 Fourteen green leaves
- ✝️ Optional crocheted cross
- 👗 Embroidered floral dress
- 🌱 Green cloak with yellow star embroidery
- 😊 Soft embroidered facial features
- 🧸 Fully stuffed body with stable construction

With patience and careful attention to each step, you'll create a beautiful heirloom-quality amigurumi doll that closely matches the tutorial design and is suitable for gifting, collecting, or displaying.
